

## CHAPTER 2

### POPULATION

Nigeria is the most populous country in Africa, and it comprises over 250 socio-linguistic groups.

The Nigerian Constitution provides for a census of population every 10 years primarily for socio-economic development of the country and for apportioning of members of the Senate, House of Representatives, State Houses of Assembly and Local Government Legislature. The Census also provides information on household characteristics.

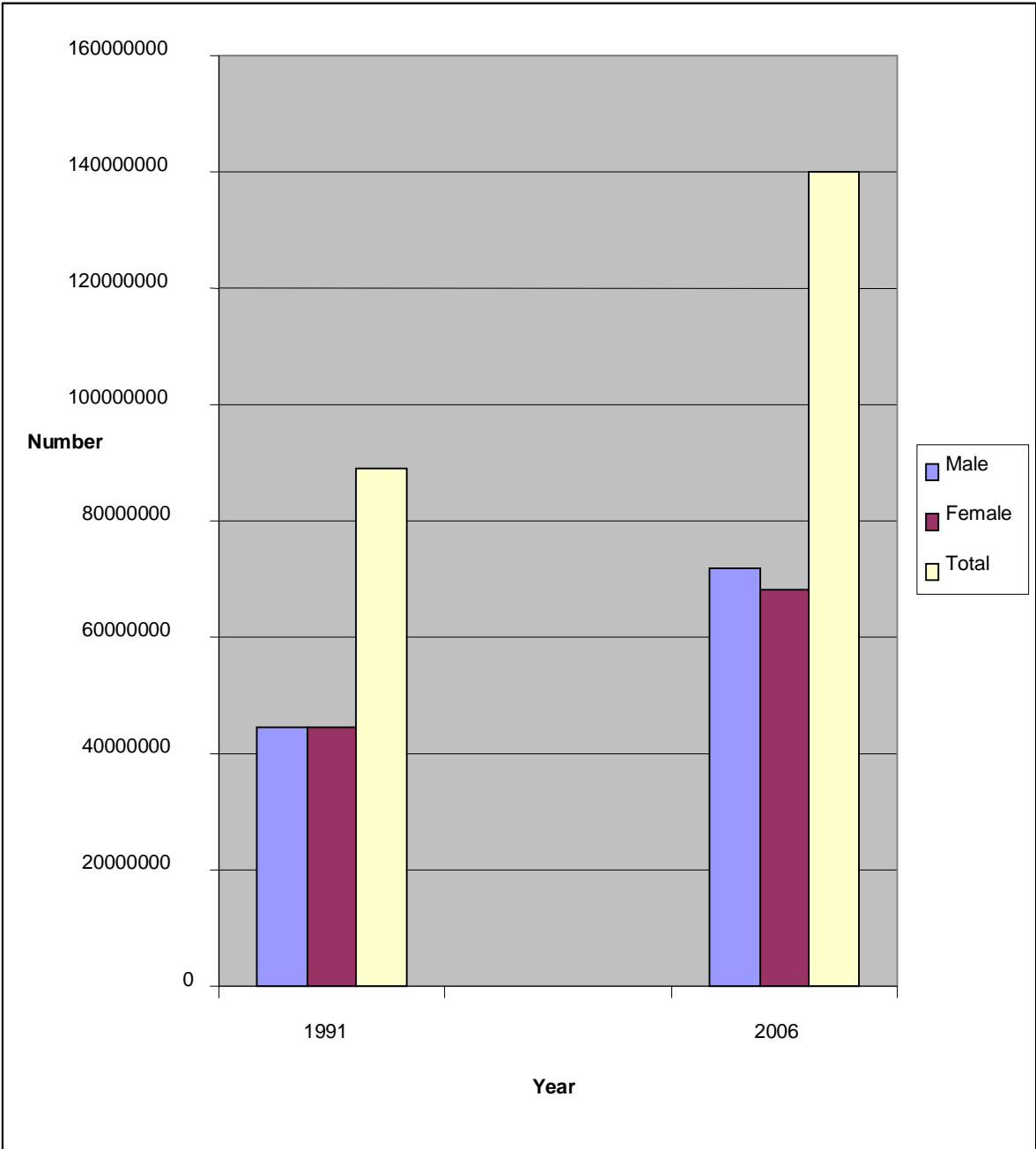
