

CHAPTER 5
JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The data on prisons are sourced from the Nigeria Prisons Service. The statistical tables include the number and capacity of prisons by gender, prison admission by type of offence, admission by religion and inmate population.

The data on public order are sourced from the Nigeria Police Force. They cover crimes, road accident cases and casualties, armed robbery cases and Involvement, vehicles stolen and recovered, court Cases, juvenile cases and bank frauds.

CHART 3: PRISON INMATE POPULATION, 2002 - 2006

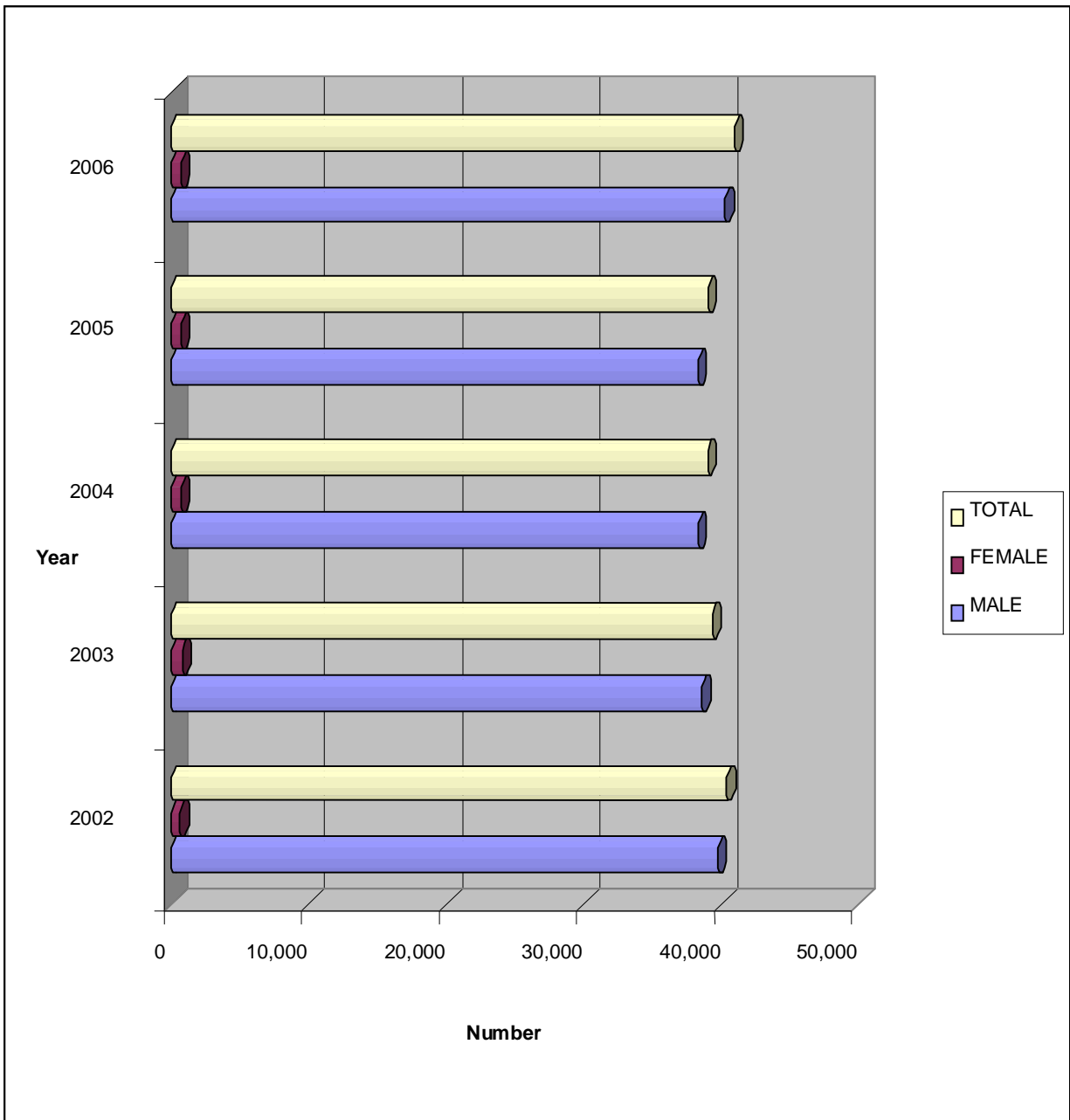

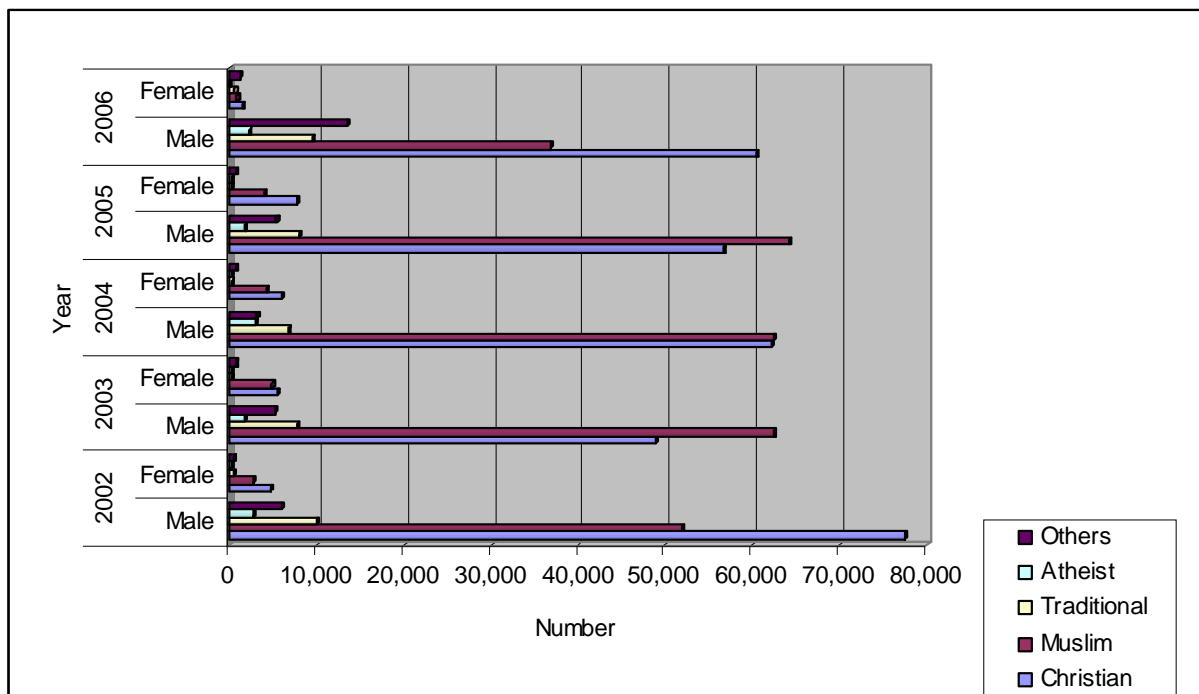

CHART 5: MINOR CRIMES AND OFFENCES REPORTED TO THE POLICE, 2002 - 2006

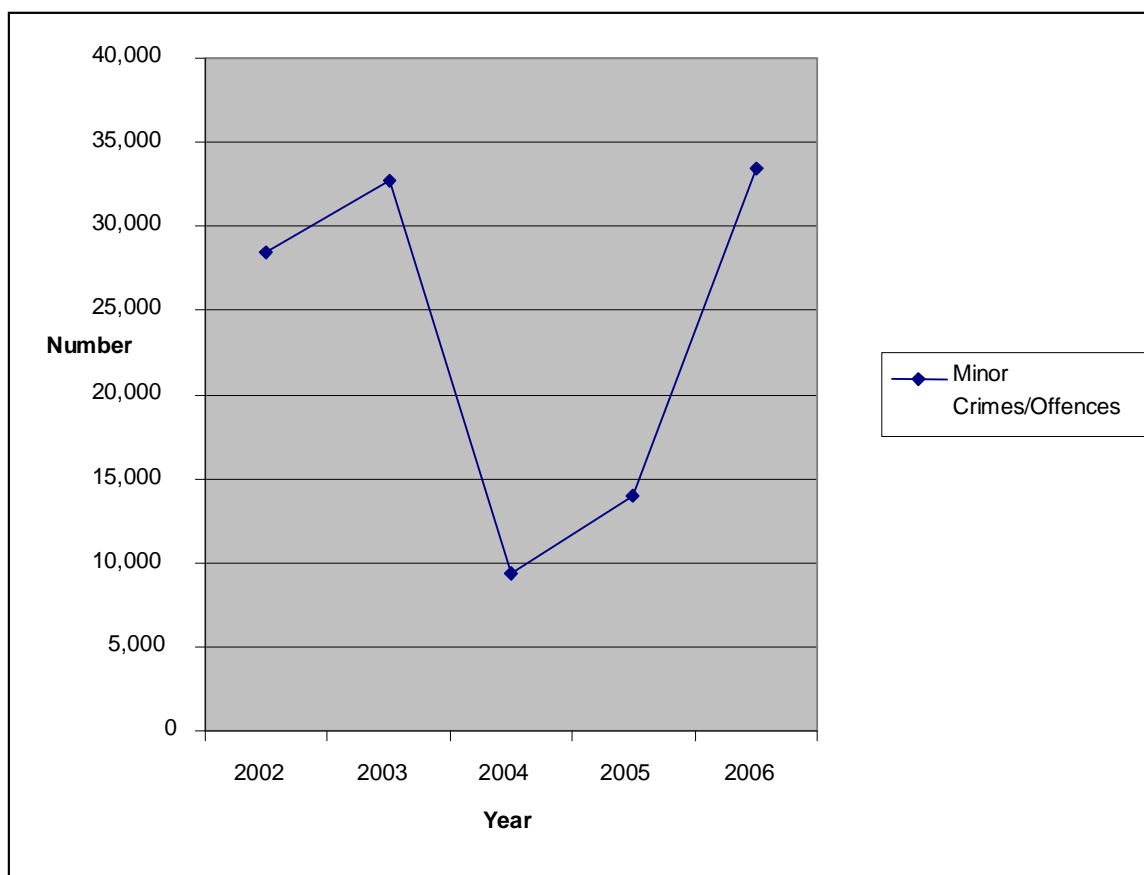

CHART 6: SERIOUS CRIMES REPORTED TO THE POLICE, 2002 - 2006

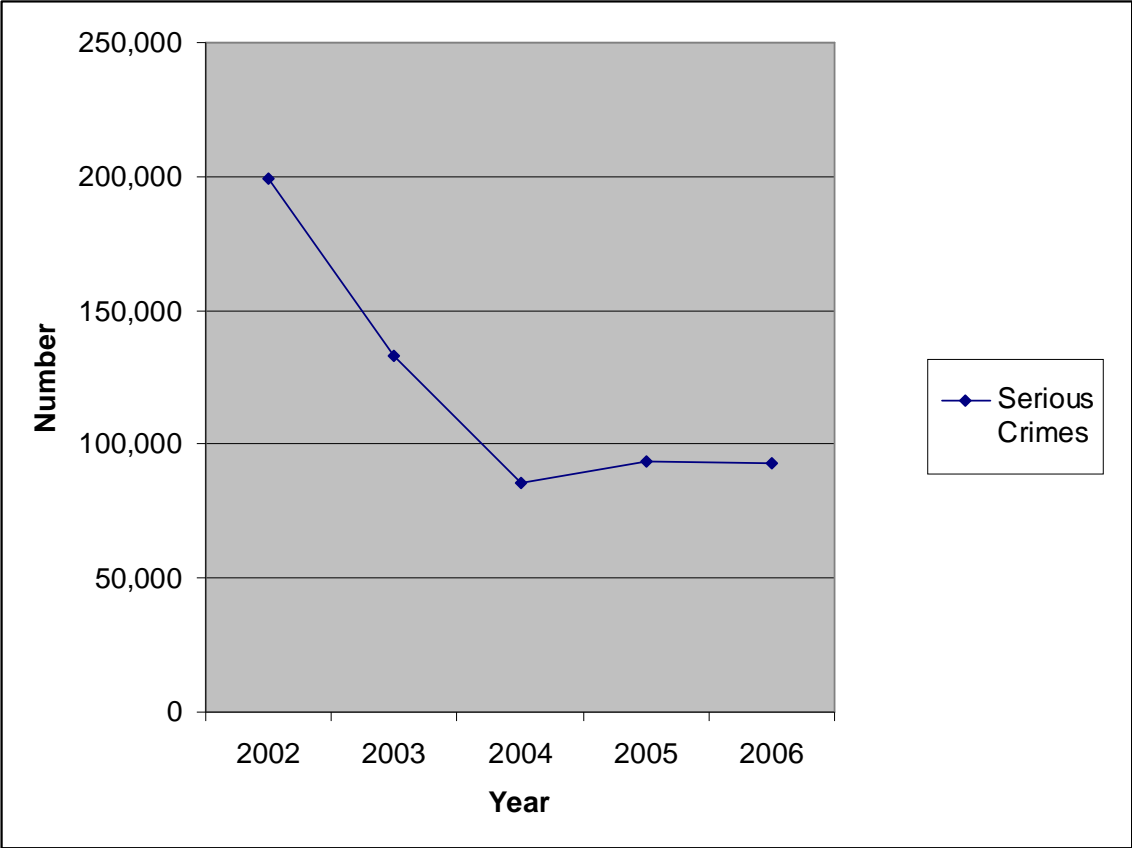

CHART 7: REPORTED ARMED ROBBERY CASES, 2002 - 2006

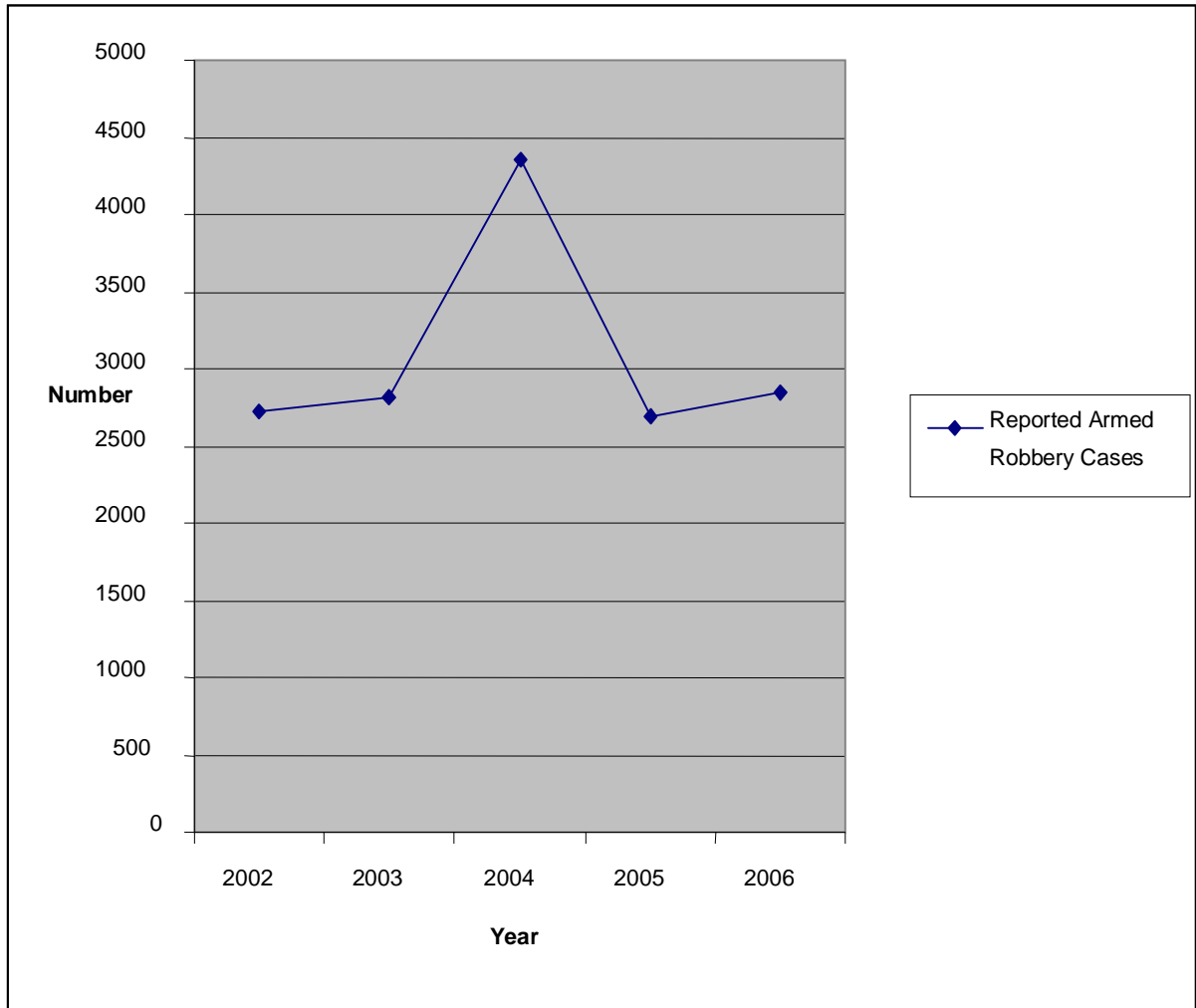

CHART 8: REPORTED ROAD ACCIDENT CASES, 2003 - 2007

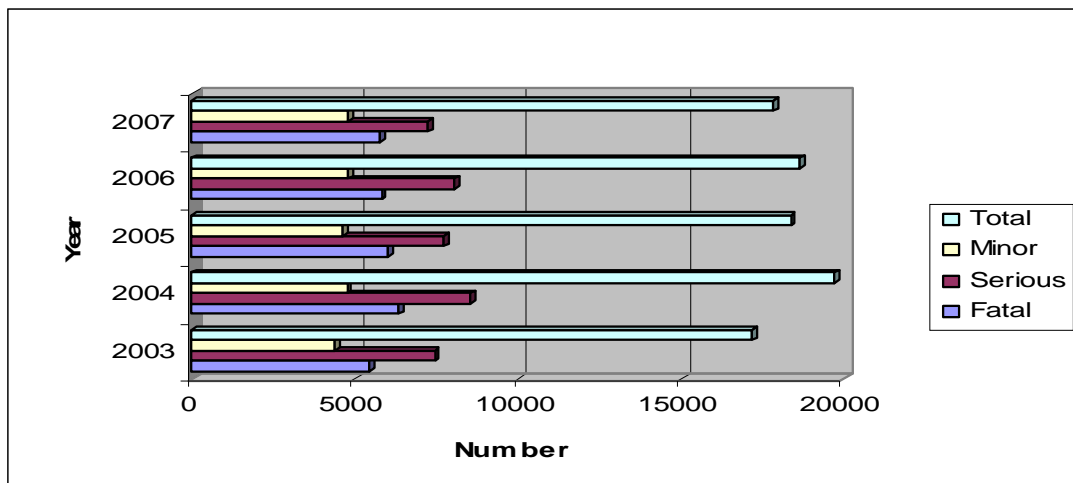


CHART 9: REPORTED ROAD ACCIDENT CASUALTIES, 2003 – 2007

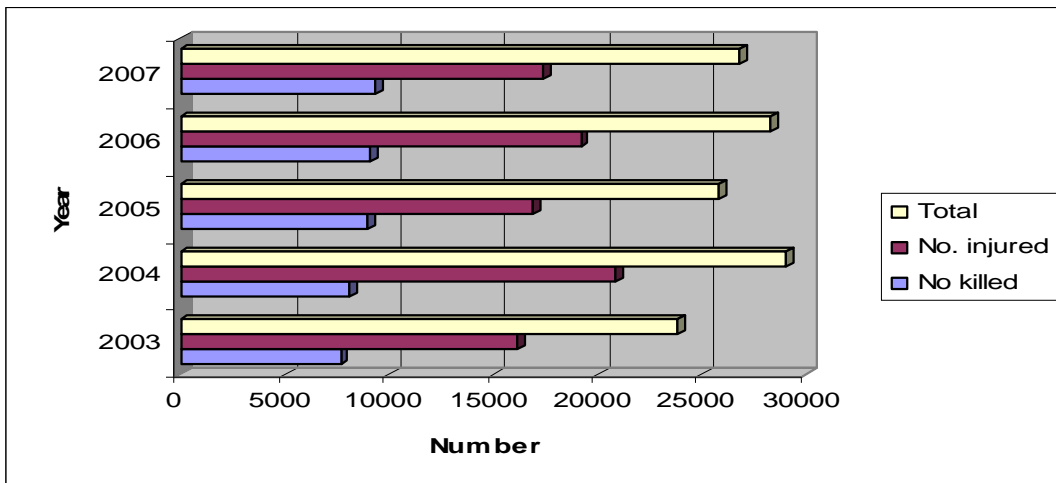
