

CHAPTER 7
EMPLOYMENT

This chapter presents data on employment in selected sectors of the economy and on unemployment. Unemployment estimation adopted by Nigeria is based on 39 hours of work in a week, rather than the International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition of one-hour work in a week.

Other data cover employment creation programmes undertaken by the National Directorate of Employment, employment in the civil service, registered unemployment and vacancies declared, trade disputes, among others.
