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Brief Methodology

The CPI measures the average changeover time in prices of goods and servicesconsumed by people for day to-dayliving. The construction of the CPI combines economic theory, sampling and other statistical techniques using datafrom other surveys to produce a weightedmeasure of average price changes in the Nigerian economy. The weighting occursto capture the importance of the selected commodities in the entire index. The production of the CPI requires skills of economists, statisticians, computerscientists, data collectors and others.

Key in the construction of the price indexis the selection of the market basket ofgoods and services. Every month, 10,534 informants spread across the countryprovide price data for the computation of the CPI. The market items currently comprise of 740 goods and services regularly priced.

The first stage in the calculation of the CPI is the collection of prices on each item (740 goods and services) from outlets in each sector (rural or urban) for each state. Prices are then averaged for each item per sector across the state. The next step is to use the average price to calculate the basic index for each commodity: The current year price of each commodity is compared with a base year's price to obtain a relative price.

Next we use the Laspeyres formula to compute an aggregated index for each class (which has a multitude of commodities which have similar consumption purposes): Here the sum of the product of weights (obtained from the expenditure survey) and relative prices for each item is divided by the sum of the weight of the items in that class, and the result multiplied by 100 gives the required index number. This index number is still classified according to the urban or rural classification sector for each of the 36 states and the FCT. This yields 85 classes then 48 groups which are then reclassified into 12 Divisions to derive:

- 1. The country composite index
- 2. The Urban National index
- 3. The Rural National index
- 4. The Combined Urban and Rural State Composite index


The survey methodology generates 3774 all items indices for all states and the FCT.

This edition of the Statistical News contains the revised Consumer Price Index (CPI) based on Nigeria Living Standard Survey (NLSS) 2003/2004. The consumption expenditure data were revalued to November 2009, which is the base period for the revised CPI.

The May 2003 and September 1985 based indices are being continued using factors derived from the new CPI. These indices will yield the same price change for any commodity group contained in all the series. A new sub index – Imported Food Index- is available in the revised CPI.

Note: The urban and rural indices were weighted with the ratio of their populations to the national i.e. 0.455 and 0.545 respectively to compute the composite indices at the 12 Classification of Individual Consumption by Purpose (COICOP) functions and all items levels. This may cause variance between a recalculated all items index using the weights published on table 2 and the published all items index because thepublished weights were computed only from consumption expenditure survey result. All Items Index

On a Headline basis, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) which measures inflation increased by 17.78 percent (year-on-year) albeit at a slower pace in February 2017, 0.94 percent points lower from the rate recorded in January (18.72) percent. This represents the first time in 15 months that the headline CPI has declined on year on year basis representing the effects of slower rises in already highfood and non food prices and favourable base effects over 2016 prices.

Price Increases were recorded in all COICOP divisions that yield the Headline Index. However, the majordivisions responsible for accelerating the pace of the increase in theheadline index were Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuel, Education, Food and Alcoholic Beverages, Clothing and Frontware and Transportation Services.

On a month-on-month basis, the Headline index increased by 1.49 percent in February 2017, 0.48 percentpoints higher from the rate of 1.01 percent recorded in January.

The Food Index increased by 18.53 percent (year-on-year) in February, up by 0.71 percent points from raterecorded in January (17.82) percent driven by increases in the prices of bread, cereals, meat, fish, potatoes, yams and other tubers and wine, while the slowest increase in food prices year on year were recorded by Soft Drinks, Coffee, Tea and Cocoa.

Price movements recorded by All Items less farm produce or Core sub *It should be noted that the Headline Index* is made up of the Core Index and Farm Produce items. As. Processed Foods are included in both the Core and Food sub-indices; this Implies that these sub-indices are not mutually-exclusive.

index rose by 16.00 percent (year -on-year) in February, down by 1.90 percent points from rate recorded in January (17.90) percent.

During the month, the highest year on year increases were seen in electricity, Liquid and solid fuels, Fuels and lubricants for personal transport equipment, Clothing materials, other articles of clothing and clothing accessories and book and stationaries

The Urban index rose by 18.57 percent (year-on-year) in February from 20.31 percent recorded in January, and the Rural index increased by 16.98 percent in February from 17.34 percent in January.

On month-on-month basis, the urbanindex rose by 1.52 percent in February from 1.03 percent recorded in January, while the rural index rose by 1.47 percent in February from 1.00 percent in January.

The corresponding twelve-month year-on-year average percentage change for the urban index increased from 17.91 percent in January to 18.42 percent in February, while the corresponding rural index also increased from 15.18 percent in January to 15.70 percent in February.

The Composite Food Index rose by 18.53 percent in February 2017. The rise in the index was driven by increases in the prices of bread, cereals, meat, fish, potatoes, yams and other tubers, vegetables, wine, milk, cheese and eggs, Sugar, jam, honey, chocolate and confectionery and fruit.

On a month-on-month basis, the Foodsub-index increased by 1.99 percent in February, up by 0.7 percent points from 1.29 percent recorded in January.

All Items Less Farm Produce

The average annual rate of change of the Food sub-index for the twelvemonth period ending in February 2017 over the previous twelve-month average was 16.13 percent, 0.59 percent points from the averageannual rate of change recorded in January (15.54 percent).

The "All Items Less Farm Produce" or Core sub-index, which excludes the prices of volatile agricultural produce eased by 16.0 percent during the month o February 2017, 1.90 percent points from 17.90 percent recorded in January as all key divisions which contributes to the index increased at a slower rate.

During the month of February, the highest year on year increases were seen in Electricity, Liquid and solid fuels, Fuels and lubricants for personal transport equipment, Clothing materials, other articles of clothing and clothing accessories, book and stationaries, garments, Vehicle spare parts, shoes and other footwear, passenger transport by road, household textiles, Furniture and furnishings, Motorcars and Carpets and other floor coverings.

On a month-on-month basis, the Core sub-index increased by 1.10 percent in February, 0.42 percent points higher from 0.68 percent recorded in January. The average 12-month annual rate of rise of the index was recorded at 16.44 percent for the twelve-month period ending in February 2017, 0.40 percent points higher from the twelve month rate of change recorded in January.


