In line with the dissemination policy of the National Population Commission (NPopC) on the 2006

Population and Housing Census, three sets of publications have been released to give details to

variables canvassed during the census. The first publication gives the total enumerated persons by

administrative areas in the Country. The second is the Priority Tables (Volume 1) that provide some

detailed characteristics of the population of Nigeria by State and Local Government Areas (LGA) and

some Housing information at the National and State levels. This publication is the State's

component of the third publication which is the Priority tables (volume2).

This publication is directed at the housing characteristics and amenities at the Local Government

Area level. The vital statistics section of this publication is not included because the national

Population Commission Ondo-State Office did not render returns on the requests made by this

office. Efforts will be made to include vital statistics in the future publications. The data contained

in this publication will be useful for planning and monitoring of various government targets and

projects while at the same time satisfying the data needs of other stake holders, individuals, civil

society organisations, Development Partners, etc.

The State appreciates the Federal Government for the release of detailed information on the 2006

Population and Housing Census.

Constructive Criticism will be highly appreciated for the improvement of future publication.

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METADATA

The metadata describes the concepts and explains the variables presented in the publication to facilitate ease of understanding and use by various stakeholders.

Household and types of Household

Regular Household: is a household that consists of a person or a group of persons living together usually under the same roof or in the same building/compound, which shares the same source of food and recognises themselves as a social unit with a head of household. There are two major types of household recognised: regular and institutional. The criteria used to categorise regular and institutional households were "presence of recognised head of household", "sharing of catering arrangement" and "feeling of belonging together as a social unit".

There were other types of household classification/identification used during the census: Homeless households, homeless persons and nomadic households, transient persons, fishing and hunting, population and Census functionaries.

- Homeless persons: were single persons who had no home of their own, i.e. they do not live in any permanent homes but were enumerated while roaming around. They often slept under bridges, in market stalls and railway stations or motor parks. They consisted mostly of vagabonds, lunatics and persons with no fixed abode.
- *Nomadic Households*: were the households of herdsmen who are always on the move. They were identified differently because their residences were known to be very temporary.
- Households with head absent: were households whose heads were away at the time of enumeration.
- Regular Households: It usually recognises one of its members as the head; shares common
 catering arrangements and members conduct themselves as a social unit. A one-person
 household consists of a single man or woman and a multi-person household consists of two
 or more members.
- *Institutional Household:* is defined as collective household in which members do not have any recognized head.

- HOMELESS PERSON: Were individuals who slept in public places such as footpath, pavement of markets, shopping centres and Motor Park.
- NOMADIC HOUSEHOLD: Were persons who migrate from one place to another in search of
 pastures for their animals, such as some Fulani herdmen. By their characteristics they do not
 settle in a place for a long period, live in groups with identifiable household, and stay in
 semi-permanent structure.
- TRANSIENT PERSONS: Were individuals who were on their way out of or into a country at a time of enumeration and are not likely to be enumerated with the normal households such transit passengers at seaport, airports, and international motor parks.
- FISHING AND HUNTING HOUSEHOLD: Were people on fishing or hunting expedition who were not returning to their regular homes at the time of enumeration.

HOUSING

- REGULAR HOUSEHOLD: This is a person or group of persons living together under the same roof or in the same building/compound, who share the same source of food and recognize themselves as a social unit with a head of household.
- TYPE OF HOUSING UNIT: This refers to the type of residence occupied by the household as at the time of census enumeration. Several types of housing units were distinguished; they were houses on separate stand or yard, traditional/hut structures made of traditional materials, flat in block of flats, semi-detached house, rooms/let in house, informal/improvised dwellings and other types of housing unit not mentioned.
- SLEEPING ROOMS: These are rooms under exclusive use for sleeping by all members of the households during census. A room used for purposes other than sleeping (that is used for sleeping purposes as a parlour or kitchen or shop or office or garage etc) were not considered as sleeping room.
- FLOOR (FINISH): This is the main material used for the largest part of the floor of the dwelling occupied by the household. The area of interest here is the largest part of the floor, for example, the finishing of the sitting room might be marble while the 6 sleeping rooms cement finishing. Since the finishing of the major part of the dwelling is cement, cement is considered as the floor finishing. The floor material listed include; earth/mud/mud brick, wood/bamboo, cement/concrete, stone, burnt brick, vinyl tiles, ceramic marble tiles, terrazzo and others.

- WALL (FINISH): This is the main material used for the outside walls of the housing unit.
 Outer wall refers to the walls of the main building and not to the fence that may surround the building/compound. These include; mud/reed, wood/bamboo, stone, cement/blocks/bricks, metal/zinc sheet and others.
- ROOF: This is the main construction material used for the roof the housing unit. These are thatch/palm leaves/raffia, wood/bamboo, earth/mud/mud bricks, corrugated metal/zinc sheet, slate/asbestos, cement/concrete, roofing tiles and others.
- TENURE STATUS: This is the form of ownership or tenancy under which the household occupies the building/compound. By 'owned' it means one of the members of the household alone or together with other household members owns the housing unit, the housing unit is fully paid off, and no rent is paid to anybody. the tenure status could be owned, owned but not yet paid off, rented, occupied rent-free, squatting and others.
- OWNERSHIP STATUS: This is actual owner of the housing unit where the household reside. The ownership include, head of household, spouse to the head of household, other household member, relative but not household member, privately owned (landlord), private employer, other private agency, public/government ownership and others.
- WATER SUPPLY: This is the main source of water for domestic activities, such as drinking, cooking, bathing and washing. The sources include, pipe-borne inside dwelling, pipe-borne outside dwelling, tanker supply/water vendor, well, bore-hole, rainwater, rivers/stream/spring, dugout/pond/lake/dam/pool and others.
- TOILET FACILITY: This is a place primarily meant for the disposal of human waste. The main toilet available for the household was recorded. These include; water closet, pit latrine, bucket/pan, toilet facility in another (different) dwelling, public toilet, nearby (bush/beach/field) and others.
- COOKING FUEL: This is the main sources of fuel for the preparation of meal by the household. The source could be electricity, gas, kerosene, firewood, coal, animal dung/sawdust/coconut husk, solar and others that have not been mentioned.
- LIGHTING FUEL: This is the main source of power used for lighting at night by the household. Six types of lighting energy/fuel are distinguished as electricity, gas, kerosene, candle, solar, and others.

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL: Solid waste are rubbish (refuse), excluding excreta, generated by members of the household. Solid waste does not include the liquid waste from kitchen, bathroom, washing places and disposed off through sewage or gutter or thrown onto the street. Six types of solid waste disposal distinguished as; collected, buried by household, public approved dump, unapproved dump site, burnt by household and others.

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OBSERVATIONS:

- A. Household and types of Housing Units: Total population of the State according to the 2006 Population Census is put at 3,460,877 (Tables 2a & 2b). This population is distributed into a total of 763020 regular households (Table 2). The figures indicate that 55.44% of the household are houses on separate stand or yard while 21.0% of the households are Rooms/Let in houses. The details show that 10.59% are households of flats / block of flats, 6.0% are semidetached houses, 4.98% are traditional/hut structures made of traditional materials, 1.6% are households not mentioned while 0.27% are formal/improvised dwelling. The breakdown by LGA shows that all the LGAs followed the state pattern except Akure South LGA where 46.36% are households of Rooms/Let in house while 25.76% are households of houses on separate stand or yard.
- B. Data on distribution of regular households by number of exclusive sleeping rooms are presented in Tables 3a & 3b. It was observed that a total of 72,086 representing 9.45% household do not have rooms exclusively for sleeping. Highlights of data on distribution of regular households by number of Exclusive sleeping rooms indicated that 16.71% has one room, 16.70% has two rooms, 14.09% has three rooms, 14.10% has four rooms, 6.13% has five rooms, 8.11% has six rooms, 3.06% has seven rooms while 11.64% has Eight rooms and above.
- C. The distribution of regular households by type of main materials used for the floor of the dwelling units indicated that cement/concrete is the main material most used for the floors of dwelling units in the State. 63.23% of the housing units used cement/concrete, 24.32% used earth/mud/mud bricks while 8.87% used wood/bamboo (Tables 4a & 4b)
- D. Materials used for wall of dwelling units are highlighted in Tables 5a & 5b. It is observed that the walls of the dwelling units of most households (60.93%) are made with cement/blocks/bricks.

Other observations as presented in Tables 5a & 5b are as follows:

- Mud/Reed is still favoured after blocks/bricks as it accounts for 26%.
- E. From Tables 6a & 6b, 62.57% of the total regular household had the roofs of their dwelling units covered with corrugated metal/Zinc sheets.
- F. Over half of the entire dwelling units in the State are owned by the occupiers. Details from Tables 7a & 7b showed that 34.64% are rented, 11.08% are occupied rent free, 1.65% are owned but not paid off, 0.57% are occupied by squatting while the balance of 0.25% are owned by others.
- G. Ownership status of dwelling units indicates that 59.09% of the dwelling units are owned by head of household. Other ownership status are:

 Private owned (Landlord) 16.38%, other household members 13.08%, Relative but not household member 3.48%, Spouse to head of household

 3.19%, Public/Government ownership 1.87%, Private employer 1.55%, Other Private agencies and others account for 0.87% and 0.48% respectively.
- H. The source of water for domestic purpose for majority of households is well. A total of 338,579 (44.37%) have well as source of water supply for domestics purpose.
- I. Highest proportion of the households (42.82%) had the pit latrines as means of toilet facility within their housing units.
- J. Most households used firewood as cooking fuel, followed closely by Kerosene. Smallest proportion of the households (0.09%) used solar as cooking fuel.


- K. Kerosene is used by 54.34% of the households as lighting fuel while electricity is used by 42.05% of the households for the same purpose. Solar energy is not widely used as the data showed that only 0.19% used it as lighting fuel.
- L. Majority of the households in the State (43.88%) disposed their solid waste in unapproved dump sites. 25.50% of the households burnt solid waste, 13.97% dropped solid waste at approved dumpsites. Solid wastes in 9.44% of the households are collected while it is buried in 5.62% households. 1.60% of the households disposed solid waste through other means.
- M. Access to Telephone in most regular households (42.03%) was at a business centre. 32.95% of the regular households had no access telephone. Other distributions of access to telephone are: At a neighbour nearby (9.81%), at a public telephone nearby (6.32%), place of work (5.91%), others (2.98%).
- N. A total of 362,119 (47.46%) do not have access to television. Other households had access to television through neighbours nearby (33.80%), place of work (7.53%), public television viewing centre nearby (5.62%) and other means (5.59%).






Fig 4: % DISTRIBUTION OF REGULAR HOUSEHOLDS BY TYPE OF HOUSING UNITS AND LGA IN ONDO-STATE




Fig 5: % DISTRIBUTION OF REGULAR HOUSEHOLDS BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA IN ONDO-STATE





















































