## Merchandise Trade Growth Declines in Q1 2013:

## Declining exports and rising imports

 led to weak trade balance.
## Total Merchandise Trade

Nigeria's external merchandise trade totalled N5,098.9billion in the First Quarter of 2013, a decrease of N2,086.9 billion or $29 \%$ from the $\mathrm{N} 7,185.8 \mathrm{billion}$ recorded in the previous quarter. The decrease emanated mainly from the fall in the value of exports from N5,892.9 billion in the Fourth Quarter, 2012 to N3,452.1billion in the First Quarter, 2013 a $41.4 \%$ decline. Furthermore, a $27.4 \%$ increase in imports from N1,292.8 billion in the Fourth Quarter, 2012 to N1,646.7billion in the First Quarter 2013 in combination with a decrease in exports, created a decline in the trade balance by $\mathrm{N} 2,794.7$ or $60.8 \%$ during the period.

Year-on-year, the value of the nation's total merchandise trade decreased by $\mathrm{N} 1,523.1$ billion or $23.0 \%$ as a result of decreasing imports and exports. A drop in exports compared to imports also led to a decline in the trade balance by $45.6 \%$ during this period as well. Crude oil exports stood at N3,030.7 billion during the First Quarter of 2013, a decrease of N1,072.0billion or $26.1 \%$ when
compared with the previous quarter (Table1). Crude oil exports were also down by $18.5 \%$ year on year.
Imports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and Country of Origin.

Nigeria's imports were valued at N1,646.7 billion in the First Quarter of 2013, a marginal decline of $0.3 \%$ year-on-year. Imports were however up by $27.4 \%$ or N353.9 billion from $\mathrm{N} 1,292.8$ billion recorded in the previous quarter. The increase in imports emanated from substantial rises in the value of major products classified by SITC such as; Crude Inedible Materials, Mineral fuels, and Commodities not elsewhere classified with N125.6 billion, N1.2 billion and 482.6 billion respectively.

Details of imports classified by sections showed that Mineral Products accounted for the largest share of imports with N639.2billion or $38.8 \%$ of total imports. Other imports into Nigeria during the period include Boilers, Machinery and Appliances and Associated parts, Plastic, Rubber and Associated articles, and Vehicles Aircraft and Parts, with N236.3billion or 14.4\%, N185.9billion or $11.3 \%$ and N143.8billion or $8.7 \%$ (Table2).

Nigerian imports by Broad Economic Category revealed that Fuels and Lubricants accounted for N506.4billion or $30.7 \%$ of imports, followed by Goods Not Elsewhere Specified with N401.8billion or $24.4 \%$, Industrial Supplies with N341.0 billion or 20.7\%, and Capital Goods and Associated Parts with N165.2 or 10.0\% (Table7).

Analysis of Nigeria's imports, according to Country of Origin revealed that China, United Kingdom, Belgium, United states and Netherlands ranked the first five positions in terms of trading partners with N335.8billion, N98.9billion, N93.4billion, N84.3billion and N80.9billion respectively.

Summary of imports by continents revealed that Europe ranked first with N542.4billion or $32.9 \%$ of total imports. This was followed by Asia with N519.4billion or $31.5 \%$, Oceania and other countries with N398.6billion or $24.2 \%$, The Americas with N127.7 billion or $7.8 \%$, and Africa with N58.7billion or $3.6 \%$. ECOWAS contributed N5.3billion or $9.1 \%$ of total imports from Africa (Table4).

## Exports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and

## Country of Destination

The value of Nigeria's exports stood at N3,452.1billion in the First Quarter 2013, a decrease of N1,517.6billion or $30.5 \%$ from the First Quarter of 2012 (Table1). Further comparison with the Fourth Quarter of 2012 indicates that the value of Nigeria's exports declined by N2,440.8 or 41.4\%.

Analysis on exports by Section revealed that Mineral products contributed N3,034.2billion or $87.9 \%$ of total exports during the quarter, followed by Plastic, Rubber and Associated Articles with N168.1billion or 4.9\%, and Prepared Foodstuffs, Beverages, Spirit, Vinegar and Tobacco with N115.2billion or $3.3 \%$ (Table3). Exports to various continents showed that Europe ranked first with N1,657.5billion or $48 \%$ of total exports, followed by The Americas with N830.2billion or $24.1 \%$, Asia with N591.8billion or $17.1 \%$ and Africa with N304.2billion or $8.8 \%$. Out of the exports to Africa, ECOWAS contributed N178.2billion or $58.6 \%$. Exports by Country of destination showed that United States took the lead with N414.1billion, followed by Netherlands with N386.0billion, Brazil with N343.0billion, India with N332.6billion and Spain with N327.6billion.





## Methodology

The National Bureau of Statistics publishes this Trade statistics report quarterly. Trade statistics compilation by NBS is largely from secondary data sources.

## Data Sources:

The Nigerian Customs through the Nigeria Integrated Customs Information System, Cobalt International Plc (on export commodities), Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation and various oil companies in the upstream and downstream sectors of the oil industry, Nigerian Ports, Petroleum Products Price Regulatory Agency, Central Bank of Nigeria.

## Validation \& Quality Assurance:

After collecting data from the above sources, it is verified for outliers, Data validation is undertaken through a sample of the various Nigerian Customs outposts in Nigeria. Equally, regular visits are paid to the various outposts of Cobalt International for export validation using the extensive NBs field network. Weight harmonization is carried out through the various entry posts of imports and exports in Nigeria.

## Processing/Analysis:

Data processing is done using the Global Eurotrace software and the processed data is banked in the trade database. We use the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) to categorize trade items.
