Merchandise Trade Growth In Q4 2013:

Exports outperform imports resulting in favourable trade balance.

Total Merchandise Trade

The total value of Nigeria's external merchandise trade stood at N5,162.9 billion in the fourth quarter of 2013. This was N495.3billion lower than N5,658.2 billion recorded in the previous quarter, representing an 8.8% decline.

The observed change was as a result of decline in the value of imports and exports by 19.1% and 2.7% respectively from the previous quarter. The value of imports declined from 2,084.8 billion in the Third Quarter, 2013 to N1,686.1 billion in the Fourth Quarter 4, 2013, while the value of exports declined from N3,573.2 billion to N3,476.8 billion over the same period. The resulting trade balance of N1,790.8 billion presented an increase of N302.2 billion or 20.3% from the preceding quarter.



Comparison with the fourth quarter of the previous year revealed that the value of the nation's total merchandise trade declined by 28.2%, or N2,022.9 billion. Total trade stood at N21,261.1billion for the 2013 calendar year, 24.3%, or N6,810.1billion lower than N28,071.2 billion recorded for 2012, as a result of a decline in exports by 36.5%. The crude oil component of total exports stood at N2,981.7 billion for the Fourth Quarter, while the non-crude oil accounted for N495.2billion (Table1).

Imports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and Country of Origin.

The value of Nigeria's imports amounted to N1, 686.1billion in the Fourth Quarter of 2013. This represents a decline of N398.7billion or 19.1% from the N2, 084.8billion recorded against the Third Quarter of 2013. Year on year, the value of imports were N393.2 billion or 30.4% greater than the value recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2012. According to the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC), compared to the Third Quarter of 2013, the decline in imports can be can be attributed to the fall in the value of imports of "Beverages and Tobacco" by N202.1billion or 93.8%, and a N25.0billion or 56.7% decline in the value of "Crude Inedible Materials" (Table 6).

When classified by Section, "Boilers, Machinery and Appliances" accounted for the largest share of imports, with N355.9 billion or 21.1% of total imports. Other significant imports to Nigeria during the period included "Vehicles, Aircraft and Parts Thereof" with N293.6 billion or 17.4% and "Mineral Products" with N230.3 billion or 13.7% of the total import bill (Table 2). Imports categorised by Broad Economic Category show that "Industrial supplies" contributed the largest percentage to imports, accounting for N464.7 billion or 27.6% of the total imports. "Capital goods" and "Food and Beverages" follow, with N426.1 billion or 25.3%, and N269.1billion or 16.0%, of the total imports respectively (Table7).

Summarising imports by region shows that the greatest value of imports to Nigeria in the fourth quarter of 2013 came from Asia, with N746.9 billion or 44.3% of total imports. This was followed by Europe with N554.6 billion (32.9%), The Americas with N267.3 billion (15.9%), Africa with N102.8 billion (6.1%) and Oceania with N14.4 billion (0.9%). ECOWAS contributed N48.0 billion, or 46.7% of the total imports from the Africa region. The individual countries with the five greatest import values are China, United States, South Korea, Netherlands and India, with Nigeria consuming N374.1billion, N185.1billion, N122.5 billion, N95.7 billion and N90.7 billion of goods respectively. The total imports for the 2013 calendar year amounted to N7,015.8billion, N1,390.9 billion or 24.7% greater than the cumulative total for 2012.


Exports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and Country of Destination


The value of Nigeria's exports stood at N3,476.8 billion in the Fourth Quarter of 2013, a moderate decline of N96.5 billion or 2.7% from N3,573.4 billion recorded in the previous quarter. Exports are however N2,416.1 billion or 41% lower than the value recorded for the fourth quarter of the preceding year (Table1).


Analysis of exports by section reveals that "Mineral Products" dominate Nigerian exports, contributing N3,167.0billion or 91.1% of the total. This is followed by "Prepared Foodstuffs, Beverages, Spirit and Vinegar, Tobacco" with N100.9 billion or 2.9%, and "Vegetable Products" with N 51,641.0 billion or 1.5% of total exports of the quarter (Table 3).


In the Fourth Quarter of 2013, the continent that consumed the largest share of Nigerian exports was Europe, receiving N1,416.8billion or 40.8% of the total exports. This is followed by Asia with N881.7 billion or 25.4% of exports, Africa with N439.8 billion or 12.7%, and The Americas with N435.5billion or 12.5% of exports. Of the

total exports to Africa, ECOWAS consumed N167.8billion or 38.2%. When classified according to country of destination, India, The Netherlands, Italy, Brazil and South Africa were the greatest consumers of Nigerian exports, with values of N613.8billion, N393.7billion, N310.7billion, N289.8 billion and N218.9 billion exported to these countries respectively. Total exports for the 2013 calendar year amounted to N14,245.3 billion, lower by N8,201.0 billion or 36.5% from the value of total exports recorded for in 2012.









Methodology

The National Bureau of Statistics publishes this Trade statistics report quarterly. Trade statistics compilation by NBS is largely from secondary data sources.

Data Sources:

The Nigerian Customs through the Nigeria Integrated Customs Information System, Cobalt International Plc (on export commodities), Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation and various oil companies in the upstream and downstream sectors of the oil industry, Nigerian Ports, Petroleum Products Price Regulatory Agency, Central Bank of Nigeria.

Validation & Quality Assurance:

After collecting data from the above sources, it is verified for outliers, Data validation is undertaken through a sample of the various Nigerian Customs outposts in Nigeria. Equally, regular visits are paid to the various outposts of Cobalt International for export validation using the extensive NBs field network. Weight harmonization is carried out through the various entry posts of imports and exports in Nigeria.

Processing/Analysis:

Data processing is done using the Global Eurotrace software and the processed data is banked in the trade database. We use the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) to categorize trade items.
