Rising exports and declining imports result in a favorable trade balance

## Total Merchandise Trade

In the Second Quarter of 2012, the value of Nigeria's total Merchandise trade amounted to N7,083.9 billion, an increase of N461.9billion or 7.0\% over levels reported in the First Quarter of the year. The increase was as a result of the increase in the value of exports by N705.7 billion or 14.2\% during the quarter. In particular, Non-Crude oil exports increased by N873.5 billion or 69.7\% over levels reported in the First Quarter of 2012. Further comparison with the Second Quarter of the 2011 revealed that the value of the nation's total merchandise trade decreased by N79.0billion or 1.1\%. For the first half of 2012, the value of total Merchandise trade stood at N13, 706 billion compared to N13.488.3 billion recorded in the same period of the preceding year, an increase of N217.7 billion or 1.6\%. A combination of declining imports and rising exports (a rising from positive developments in non-oil exports) resulted in a trade balance surplus on both year-on-year and quarter-on-quarter bases.


## Imports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and Country of Origin.

The value of total Imports for the Second Quarter of 2012, stood at N1,408. billion, a decrease of $14.8 \%$ or N243.8 billion from N1,652.3 billion recorded in the previous quarter. Further comparison with the previous year revealed a sharp fall in the value of imports by $N 1,776.3$ billion or $55.8 \%$ less than the value (N3,184.8 billion ) recorded in the second quarter 2011. This was largely as a result of the decline in the importation of Food and Live Animals, Machinery and Transport Equipment and Crude Inedible Materials. The value of imports in the first half of the year stood at N3,060.7 billion compared to N6,292.3billion recorded in the corresponding part of the previous year, a decline of N3,232.0 billion or 51.3\%.

Imports by sections (Table 2) revealed that Boilers Machinery and Appliances accounted for the largest share of imports with N302.6billion or $21.5 \%$ of total imports. Other major imports into Nigeria during the period include Vegetable Products with N242.2billion or 17.2\%, Vehicle Aircraft and Parts with N179.0billion or $12.7 \%$, Base metals and Articles of Base Metal with N136.8billion or $9.7 \%$, and Products of the Chemical and Allied Industries with N126.7 billion or 9.0\% respectively. Nigeria's imports by country of origin revealed, that China, United States, Brazil, India and Germany ranked the first five positions in terms of trading partners with N286.2 billion, N180.8 billion, N159.2 billion, $N 142.5$ billion and N57.9 billion respectively. Over the first half of this year Imports by region (Table 4) showed that Asia ranked first with N1,175,9 billion or $38.4 \%$ of total Imports. This was followed by other economic regions such as Europe contributing N879.7 billion or 28.7\%, and The Americas contributing $N 805.3$ billion or $26.3 \%$, of the total imports during the period under review. Africa contributed N 113.7 or $3.7 \%$ of the total imports of which ECOWAS contributed N19.4 billion or $17.1 \%$ of the total imports from Africa.

## Exports Classified by Standard International Trade Classification and

 Country of DestinationThe value of total Exports stood at N5,675.5 billion in the Second quarter 2012, an increase of N705.7billion or $14.2 \%$ from the N4, 969.7 billion recorded in first quarter 2012. This was as a result of an increase in the value of Non crude oil exports during the quarter which increased by $69.7 \%$ to N2,127.1 billion during the period. On the other hand, Crude oil exports decreased by N167.7billion or $4.5 \%$ against the value (N3, 716.1billion) recorded in the first quarter. Further comparison with the second quarter of the previous year revealed an increase in exports of N1,6973 billion or $42.7 \%$ driven by Non-Crude oil exports in particular.

Exports by sections (Table3) revealed that Mineral Products took the lead, contributing N4,387.1 billion or $77.3 \%$ of the nation's exports, followed by Plastic Rubber and Articles with N679.9 billion or 12.0\%, Prepared Foodstuffs and Beverages with N407.2 billion or 7.2\%, and Vegetable products with N 53.7 billion or 0.9\%. With respect to Export by Country of destination, United States ranked first, followed by India, United Kingdom, Brazil and Italy in that order with N938.7billion or $16.5 \%$, N643.2billion or $11.3 \%$, N522.4 billion or $9.2 \%$, N490.1billion or $8.6 \%$ and N404.9 billion or $7.1 \%$ of total Exports respectively. Export by region in the first half of the year revealed that Europe was the largest receptor of Nigerian Exports with N3,953.4 billion or $37.1 \%$ of total Exports. This wasfollowed by the Americas recording a value of N3,379.6 billion or 31.7\% of exports, and Asia with N1,966.2 billion or $18.5 \%$ respectively. Africa received N1,043.6 billion or $9.8 \%$ of the total exports of which ECOWAS accounted for $47.9 \%$ of exports to African countries.

## Methodology

The National Bureau of Statistics publishes this Trade statistics report quarterly. Trade statistics compilation by NBS is largely from secondary data sources.

Data Sources:
The Nigerian Customs through the Nigeria Integrated Customs Information System, Cobalt International Plc (on export commodities), Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation and various oil companies in the upstream and downstream sectors of the oil industry, Nigerian Ports, Petroleum Products Price Regulatory Agency, Central Bank of Nigeria.

## Validation \& Quality Assurance:

After collecting data from the above sources, it is verified for outliers, Data validation is undertaken through a sample of the various Nigerian Customs outposts in Nigeria. Equally, regular visits are paid to the various outposts of Cobalt International for export validation using the extensive NBs field network. Weight harmonization is carried out through the various entry posts of imports and exports in Nigeria.

## Processing/Analysis:

Data processing is done using the Global Eurotrace software and the processed data is banked in the trade database. We use the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) to categorize trade items.
