KEY FINDINGS

- The data used were sourced from the National Identity Management Commission (NIMC) with information on Registered and National Identity Number (NIN) issued in 2022.
- The top 5 states with highest number of registrations and issuance of identity number were Kano (2,444,224), Lagos (2,097,912), Kaduna (1,256,479), Katsina (1,156,149) and Ogun (1,075,942).
- The least 5 states with registrations and issuance of identity number were Bayelsa (100,525), Ekiti (141,534), Ebonyi (165,375), Cross-River (268,904) and Kogi (308,681).
- In addition, registrations and issuance of identity number in the diaspora totaled 255,726, distributed into 140,496 males and 115,230 females.
- In 2022, the North-West Zone recorded the highest number of registrations and NIN issued with 7,207,695, while the South-East recorded the least with 1,793,373.
- In 2022, total registrations and NIN issued were 22,492,748, a decrease of 16.85% relative to 27,052,148 in 2021

METHODOLOGY

Data is provided by the National Identity Management Commission (NIMC), Verified and validated by National Bureau of Statistics (NBS).

1.0 INTRODUCTION



This report contains records of Nigerians that were registered and issued national identity numbers (NIN) in 2022. The figures reported cover the 36 states of the Federation, FCT and the Diaspora. Total registration and NIN issued stood at 22,492,748 in 2022, with 12,643,563 males and 9,849,185 females. The 36 states and FCT recorded 22, 237,022; while registrations in the diaspora were 255,726.




Figure 1: National Registration and National Identity Number Issued by Sex, 2022

2.0 REGISTRATIONS AND NIN ISSUED BY STATE




Figure 2: State Registrations and National Identity Number Issued, 2022

The state distribution profile shows states with top and least registrations and NIN issued. From figure 2, top three states were Kano, Lagos and Kaduna with 2,444,224, 2,097,912 and 1,256,479 respectively, while Bayelsa, Ekiti and Ebonyi recorded the lowest with 100,525, 141,534, 165,375 respectively.

3.0 DIASPORA REGISTRATIONS



Diaspora registrations cover Nigeria nationals residing in other countries. The registrations and NIN issued to diaspora stood at 255,726 in 2022, with 140,496 males and 115,230 females.

4.0 Registrations and NIN Issued By Zone

On zonal distribution, the North-West had the highest registrations and NIN issued with 7,207,695, followed by the South-West with 4,825,143. However, the South-East had the least registrations and NIN issued with 1,793,373.




Figure 4: Zonal Registrations and NIN Issued by Sex, 2022

4.1. North-Central Zone

In 2022, Niger state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the North-Central with 368,131 males and 229,047 females. In contrast, Kogi state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 163,721 males and 144,960 females.




Figure 5: Registrations and NIN Issued in the North-Central 2022

4.2 North-East Zone

In 2022, Bauchi state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the North-East with 476,042 males and 288,184 females. In contrast, Taraba state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 202,471 males and 132,470 females.




Figure 6: Registrations and NIN Issued in the North-East 2022

4.3 North -West Zone

In 2022, Kano state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the North-West with 1,322,194 males and 1,122,030 females. In contrast, Zamfara state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 358,029 males and 125,228 females.




Figure 7: Registrations and NIN Issued in the North-West 2022

4.4 South-East Zone

In 2022, Abia state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the South-East with 359,119 males and 154,375 females. In contrast, Ebonyi state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 90,346 males and 75,029 females.




Figure 8: Registrations and NIN Issued in the South- East 2022

4.5 South-South Zone

In 2022, Rivers state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the South-South with 338,291 males and 310,198 females. In contrast, Bayelsa state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 58,063 males and 42,462 females.




Figure 9: Registrations and NIN Issued in the South-South 2022

4.6 South-West Zone

In 2022, Lagos state recorded the highest registrations and NIN issued in the South-West with 1,104,042 males and 993,870 females. In contrast, Ekiti state had the least registrations and NIN issued with 76,199 males and 65,335 females.




Figure 10: Registrations and NIN Issued in the South-West 2022
