### **Executive Summary**

Average price paid by consumers for premium motor spirit (petrol) increased by 10.1% year-on-year and decreased by -0.3% month-on-month to N149.4 in March 2017 from N149.8 in February 2017.

States with the highest average price of premium motor spirit (petrol) were Yobe (N161.7), Bayelsa (N161.3) & Enugu (154.5).

States with the lowest average price of premium motor spirit (petrol) were Oyo (N145.7), Osun, Kwara,Kano.Gombe,Ekiti,Delta and Abuja (N145) and Ogun (N144.9).



**Average PMS Prices Across Zones - North Central** 





**Average PMS Prices Across Zones - North East** 





### **Average PMS Prices Across Zones - North West**





**Average PMS Prices Across Zones - South East** 





**Average PMS Prices Across Zones - South South** 





### **Average PMS Prices Across Zones - South West**







## Methodology

Field work is done solely by over 700 NBS Staff in all States of the federation supported by supervisors who are monitored by internal and external observers.

Fuel Prices are collected across all the 774 local governments across all States and the FCT from over 10,000 respondents and locations and reflect actual prices households state they actually bought those fuels together with the prices reportedly sold by the fuel suppliers.

The average of all these prices is then reported for each state and the average for the country is the average for the state.

NBS audit team subsequently conducts randomly selected verification of prices recorded.
