## Nigerian Gross Domestic Product Report Q2 2022

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## Preface

This publication provides data on Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the four quarters of 2020, the annual figure for 2020, the four quarters of 2021, the annual figure for 2021, the first and second quarter of 2022.

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are integrated system of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation on a quarterly basis. They provide a picture of the current economic status of the economy that is timelier and more frequent than that provided by Annual National Accounts (ANA). The key attribute of QNA is that they provide a reasonable level of detail of the economy that helps the government to assess, analyse, and monitor economic growth on a regular basis.

QNA adopts the same concepts, definitions, and structure as ANA. In principle, QNA covers the entire sequence of accounts and balance sheets as reflected in the 2008 System of National Accounts (2008 SNA).

Data for this analysis were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). This series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP by kind of economic activities at current and constant (2010) prices.

We are grateful to the various agencies and establishments that made their data available as input to the estimates.

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## Introduction

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been conducting Establishment Surveys to provide data for the estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the country. In 2008, NBS started to improve the GDP series by conducting Quarterly Establishment Surveys (QES) for the four quarters of each year to provide timely estimates for decision and policy making.

In 2018, the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) conducted the Quarterly Establishment Surveys for the first three quarters of 2018 (Q1-Q3/ 2018), while the fourth quarter survey for 2018, and the first, second, and third quarter surveys for 2019 were conducted in 2019. Moreover, the fourth quarter survey for 2019, and the first, second, and third quarter surveys of 2020 were conducted in 2020. Similarly, the fourth quarter survey for 2020, and the first, second, and third quarter surveys for 2021 were conducted in 2021. Nevertheless, the fourth quarter survey for 2021, and the first and second quarter surveys for 2022 were conducted this year. These surveys produced the data that were used for the compilation of the quarterly GDP for the four quarters of 2018 (Q1 - Q4, 2018), the four quarters of 2019 (Q1 - Q4, 2019), the four quarters of 2020 (Q1-Q4, 2020), the four quarters of 2021 (Q1-Q4, 2021) and the two quarters of 2022 (Q1-Q2 2022).

In subsequent sections of this report, emphasis will be given to the composition of GDP in the second quarter of 2022. The Bureau will also be looking at the corresponding quarter of 2021 and the immediate past quarter of 2022 (Q1 2022).

## Overview of GDP in Quarter Two 2022

Nigeria's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 3.54\% (year-on-year) in real terms in the second quarter of 2022. This growth rate declined from $5.01 \%$ in the second quarter of 2021 when rapid growth was recorded following the toll the COVID-19 pandemic exacted on the economy in Q2 2020. In addition, the recent rising prices have adversely impacted on the second quarter 2022 performance. The Q2 2022 growth rate decreased by $1.47 \%$ points from $5.01 \%$ growth rate recorded in Q2 2021 and increased by $0.44 \%$ points relative to $3.11 \%$ in Q1 2022. However, quarter-on-quarter, real GDP grew at $-\mathbf{0 . 3 7 \%}$ in Q2 2022, reflecting lower economic activity in Q2 2022 than in the preceding quarter.

In the quarter under review, aggregate GDP stood at N45,004,520.89 million in nominal terms. This performance is higher when compared to the second quarter of 2021 which recorded aggregate GDP of N39, 123,713.32 million, indicating a year-on-year nominal growth rate of $15.03 \%$. The nominal GDP growth rate in Q2 2022 was higher relative to the $14.99 \%$ growth recorded in the second quarter of 2021 and higher compared to the $13.25 \%$ growth recorded in the preceding quarter. For better clarity, the Nigerian economy has been classified broadly into the oil and nonoil sectors.

## The Oil Sector

The nation in the second quarter of 2022 recorded an average daily oil production of 1.43 million barrels per day (mbpd), lower than the daily average production of 1.61 mbpd recorded in the same quarter of 2021 by 0.18 mbpd and lower than the first quarter 2022 production volume of 1.49 mbpd by 0.06 mbpd . (Figure2).

Real growth of the oil sector was $-11.77 \%$ (year-on-year) in Q2 2022 indicating an increase of $0.89 \%$ points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2021. Growth increased by 14.27\% points when compared to Q1 2022 which was $-26.04 \%$. Quarter-on-Quarter, the oil sector recorded a growth rate of $-4.97 \%$ in Q2 2022. The Oil sector contributed $6.33 \%$ to the total real GDP in Q2 2022, down from the figures recorded in the corresponding period of 2021 and the preceding quarter, where it contributed $7.42 \%$ and $6.63 \%$ respectively.

## The Non-Oil Sector

The non-oil sector grew by $4.77 \%$ in real terms during the reference quarter (Q2 2022). This rate was lower by $1.97 \%$ points compared to the rate recorded same quarter of 2021 and $1.31 \%$ points lower than the first quarter of 2022. This sector was driven in the second quarter of 2022 mainly by Information and Communication (Telecommunication); Trade; Financial and Insurance (Financial Institutions); Transportation (Road Transport); Agriculture (Crop Production) and Manufacturing (Food, Beverage \& Tobacco), accounting for positive GDP growth. In real terms, the non-oil sector contributed $93.67 \%$ to the nation's GDP in the second quarter of 2022 , higher than the share recorded in the second quarter of 2021 which was $92.58 \%$ and higher than the first quarter of 2022 recorded as $93.37 \%$.

# Major Economic Sectors: Q2 2022 Mining \& Quarrying 

The Mining \& Quarrying sector consists of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Coal Mining, Metal ore and Quarrying and other Minerals sub-activities. This sector grew nominally by $49.75 \%$ (year on year) in Q2 2022. Coal Mining exhibited the highest growth rate of all the sub-activities at $71.03 \%$, followed by Quarrying and Other Minerals activity at $52.96 \%$. However, Crude Petroleum and Natural gas was the main contributor to the sector with a weight of $91.74 \%$ in Q2 2022. Comparing Q2 2022's rate of growth relative to Q2 2021 and Q1 2022 growth rates, there was a rise of $56.47 \%$ points and a rise of $23.81 \%$ points respectively. The Mining \& Quarrying sector contributed $8.20 \%$ to the overall GDP in the second quarter of 2022, higher than the contributions recorded in 2021 second quarter at $6.30 \%$ and higher than the previous quarter recorded at $7.89 \%$.

In real terms, the Mining and Quarrying sector grew by $-11.09 \%$ (year-on-year) in the second quarter of 2022. Compared to the same quarter of 2021 and the first quarter of 2022 , it was higher by $1.19 \%$ points and higher by $14.79 \%$ points respectively. Quarter on quarter, the growth rate recorded was $-2.81 \%$ during the quarter. The contribution of Mining and Quarrying to Real GDP in the quarter under review stood at $6.51 \%$, lower than the rate of $7.58 \%$ recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2021 and lower than the $6.67 \%$ recorded in the first quarter of 2022.

## Agriculture

Four sub-activities make up the Agricultural sector: Crop Production, Livestock, Forestry and Fishing. The sector grew by 13.83\% year-on-year in nominal terms in Q2 2022, showing an increase of $7.47 \%$ points from the same quarter of 2021. Looking at the preceding quarter's growth rate of $11.55 \%$, there was an increase of $2.28 \%$ points. Crop Production remained the major driver of the sector. This is evident as it accounts for $91.99 \%$ of the overall nominal growth of the sector in the second quarter of 2022.

Quarter-on-Quarter growth stood at $3.09 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022. Agriculture contributed $21.90 \%$ to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022. This figure was lower than the rate recorded for the second quarter of 2021 and higher than the first quarter of 2022 which recorded 22.13\% and $21.09 \%$ respectively.

The agricultural sector in the second quarter of 2022 grew by $1.20 \%$ (year-on-year) in real terms, a decrease of $0.10 \%$ points from the corresponding period of 2021 , and a decrease of $1.96 \%$ points from the preceding quarter which recorded a growth rate of $3.16 \%$. It grew on a quarter-on quarter basis at 3.55\%.

However, the sector contributed $23.24 \%$ to overall GDP in real terms in Q2 2022, lower than the contribution in the second quarter of 2021 and higher than the first quarter of 2022 which stood at $23.78 \%$ and $22.36 \%$ respectively.

## Manufacłuring

The Manufacturing sector is comprised of thirteen activities: Oil Refining; Cement; Food, Beverages and Tobacco; Textile, Apparel, and Footwear; Wood and Wood products; Pulp Paper and Paper products; Chemical and Pharmaceutical products; Non-metallic Products, Plastic and Rubber products; Electrical and Electronic; Basic Metal and Iron and Steel; Motor Vehicles and Assembly; and Other Manufacturing.

Nominal GDP growth of the Manufacturing sector in the second quarter of 2022 was recorded at $5.21 \%$ (year-on-year), $33.12 \%$ points lower than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2021 ( $38.33 \%$ ) and $6.51 \%$ points lower than the preceding quarter figure of $11.72 \%$. Quarter-onQuarter, growth of the sector was recorded at $-14.50 \%$ during the quarter. The contribution of Manufacturing to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022 was $12.97 \%$, lower than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2021 at 14.18\% and lower than the first quarter of 2022 at 15.06\%.

Real GDP growth in the manufacturing sector in the second quarter of 2022 was $3.00 \%$ (year-onyear), lower than the same quarter of 2021 and lower than the preceding quarter by $0.48 \%$ points and $2.89 \%$ points respectively. The Growth rate of the sector on a quarter-on-quarter basis stood at $-15.47 \%$. Real contribution to GDP in 2022 second quarter was $8.65 \%$, lower than the $8.69 \%$ recorded in the second quarter of 2021 and lower than the $10.20 \%$ recorded in the first quarter of 2022.

## Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply

The Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air conditioning Supply sector recorded a year-on-year growth of $-6.97 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022. This was $121.27 \%$ points lower than the $114.30 \%$ growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2021, and $4.56 \%$ points lower than the growth rate of $2.41 \%$ recorded in the quarter before. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector recorded a growth rate of $263.62 \%$ in Q2 2022. The contribution of Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022 was $1.39 \%$, lower than the contribution made in the corresponding quarter of 2021 at $1.72 \%$ and higher than its contribution of $0.38 \%$ in the quarter before.

In real terms, the sector grew by $-11.48 \%$ in Q2 2022, a decline from the growth rate of $78.16 \%$ recorded in the same quarter of 2021. When compared to the immediate past quarter, there was a decrease of $0.28 \%$ points from $-11.20 \%$ recorded. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew at a rate of $263.08 \%$. The contribution of this sector to real GDP in the second quarter of 2022 was $0.69 \%$, lower than the $0.80 \%$ recorded in Q2 2021. Moreso, the figure in 2022 was higher than the $0.19 \%$ recorded in Q1 2022.

## Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation

This sector grew by $25.61 \%$ in nominal terms (year-on-year) in 2022 second quarter, a fall by $20.30 \%$ points compared to the rate of $45.91 \%$ recorded in the same quarter of 2021 . There was an increase of $8.34 \%$ points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at 61.57\%. Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector contributed $0.46 \%$ to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022, higher than the $0.43 \%$ it contributed a year earlier and higher than the $0.29 \%$ contributed in the first quarter of 2022.

The real growth rate of the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector in the second quarter of 2022 was recorded at $23.73 \%$ (year-on-year), higher by $5.25 \%$ points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was an increase of $10.51 \%$ points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by $56.48 \%$ in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was $0.35 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022; higher than its contribution of $0.30 \%$ in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than in the immediate past quarter where it contributed $0.23 \%$.

## Construction

The Construction sector grew by $4.63 \%$ in nominal terms (year-on-year) in 2022 second quarter, a drop of $42.48 \%$ points compared to the rate of $47.11 \%$ recorded in the same quarter of 2021 . There was a decrease of $3.18 \%$ points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at -18.53\%. Construction contributed $7.95 \%$ to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022, lower than the $8.74 \%$ it contributed a year earlier and lower than the 9.68\% contributed in the first quarter of 2022.

The real growth rate of the construction sector in the second quarter of 2022 was recorded at 4.02\% (year-on-year), higher by $0.32 \%$ points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of $0.81 \%$ points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by $-23.68 \%$ in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was $3.21 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022; higher than its contribution of $3.19 \%$ in the same quarter of the previous year, and lower than in the immediate past quarter where it contributed $4.18 \%$.

## Trade

In the second quarter of 2022, the nominal year-on-year growth rate of Trade stood at $14.59 \%$. This indicates a decrease of $8.68 \%$ points when compared to the second quarter of 2021 growth rate of $23.27 \%$ and $0.22 \%$ points higher than the previous quarter's growth rate of $14.37 \%$. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was $4.67 \%$. Trade's contribution to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022 was $14.32 \%$, lower than the contribution in the same quarter of the previous year of $14.38 \%$, and higher than the preceding quarter recorded at $13.59 \%$.

In real terms, Trade's year-on-year growth stood at $4.51 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022, which was $17.98 \%$ points lower than the rate recorded in the previous year at $22.49 \%$, and $2.03 \%$ points lower than in the preceding quarter at $6.54 \%$ growth rate. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at $3.83 \%$. This growth was higher than the quarter-on-quarter growth recorded in the first quarter of 2022 at $-12.11 \%$. Trade's contribution to GDP was $16.81 \%$, higher than the $16.66 \%$ it represented in the previous year, and higher than the $16.13 \%$ recorded in the 2022 first quarter.

## Accommodation and Food Services

In nominal terms, Accommodation and Food Services grew by $21.95 \%$ year -on- year in 2022 second quarter. This represents an increase of $2.88 \%$ points relative to the same quarter of 2021, when the growth rate was $19.07 \%$. Growth was higher than the preceding quarter by $15.38 \%$ points when growth was $6.57 \%$. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at -53.73\%. Accommodation and Food Services contribution to nominal GDP stood at $0.52 \%$ in the second quarter of 2022, higher than the figure recorded in the previous year and lower than the first quarter of 2022. The contributions recorded are $0.49 \%$ and $1.13 \%$ respectively.

The real year-on-year growth rate for this sector in 2022 second quarter stood at $3.03 \%$, higher by $1.06 \%$ points from $1.97 \%$ recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, the growth rate was $1.10 \%$ points higher than the $1.93 \%$ recorded. Quarter-on-quarter, real growth was $-60.69 \%$. The sector in the second quarter of 2022 represented $0.39 \%$ of the real GDP, which is slightly lower than the contribution of $0.40 \%$ recorded in the second quarter of 2021 and lower than the first quarter of 2022 contribution of $1.00 \%$.

## Transportation and Storage

Six activities make up the Transportation and Storage sector: Road Transport; Rail Transport and Pipelines; Water Transport; Air Transport; Transport Services; and Post and Courier Services.

The sector grew by $53.83 \%$ in nominal terms in the second quarter of 2022 (year-on-year). This rate was lower relative to the figure of $112.56 \%$ recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2021 and higher than $-16.02 \%$ in the previous quarter. Five of the six sub-activities under the Transport and Storage industry recorded positive growth rates in the second quarter of 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter growth stood at 72.92\%. Transport activities contributed $2.79 \%$ to Nominal GDP in Q2 2022, an increase from the $2.09 \%$ recorded in the corresponding period of 2021, and higher than $1.60 \%$ recorded in the first quarter of 2022.

In real terms, the Transportation and Storage sector grew by $51.66 \%$ in Q2 2022. This rate represents a decrease of $25.15 \%$ points relative to the same quarter of the previous year and an increase of $69.07 \%$ points relative to the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter, growth was 66.19\%. The contribution of the sector to real GDP in the Q2 2022 totaled $1.84 \%$, a rise from $1.26 \%$ recorded in the preceding year and higher than $1.10 \%$ recorded in the first quarter of 2022.

# Information \& Communication 

The Information and Communication sector is composed of the four activities of Telecommunications and Information Services; Publishing; Motion Picture, Sound Recording and Music Production; and Broadcasting.

In nominal terms, in the second quarter of 2022, the sector growth was recorded at $14.11 \%$ (year-on-year), $14.18 \%$ points increase from the rate of $-0.07 \%$ recorded in the same quarter of 2021 , and $6.43 \%$ points lower than the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. The Quarter-on- Quarter growth rate recorded in the second quarter of 2022 was 14.13\%. The Information and Communications sector contributed $12.12 \%$ to the total Nominal GDP in the 2022 second quarter, lower than the rate of $12.22 \%$ recorded in the same quarter of 2021 and higher than the $10.55 \%$ it contributed in the preceding quarter.

The sector in the second quarter of 2022 recorded a growth rate of $6.55 \%$ in real terms, year-onyear. From the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2021, there was an increase of $0.99 \%$ points. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector exhibited a growth of $13.41 \%$ in real terms. Of total real GDP, the sector contributed $18.44 \%$ in 2022 second quarter, higher than in the same quarter of the previous year in which it represented $17.92 \%$ and higher than the preceding quarter in which it represented $16.20 \%$.

## Arts, Entertainment and Recreation

In Nominal terms, the growth of Arts, Entertainment and Recreation sector was $13.25 \%$ in second quarter 2022 (year-on-year), representing a decrease of $1.76 \%$ points relative to the preceding quarter growth rate of $15.01 \%$ and an increase of $11.36 \%$ points compared with the year earlier growth rate of $1.89 \%$. On a quarterly basis, growth was recorded at $-30.62 \%$, lower than the quarter-on-quarter growth of Q1 2022 recorded at $44.33 \%$. The activity contributed $0.16 \%$ to the total nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2022. This contribution was relatively the same as the $0.16 \%$ it contributed in Q2 2021 and lower than the $0.23 \%$ it contributed in Q1 of 2022.

In real terms, the activity grew by $0.11 \%$ year-on-year which was less than the rate recorded in Q2 2021 by $1.11 \%$ points, and less by $2.19 \%$ points when compared with that of the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter, growth stood at $-31.16 \%$ in real terms. Overall, Art, Entertainment, and Recreation contributed $0.21 \%$ to real GDP in Q2 2022, relatively the same as the $0.21 \%$ recorded in 2021 and lower than $0.30 \%$ recorded in the first quarter of 2022.

## Real Estate Services

In nominal terms, Real Estate Services in the second quarter of 2022 grew by $12.81 \%$, higher by $5.44 \%$ points than the growth rate reported for the same period in 2021 and higher by $1.98 \%$ points compared to the preceding Quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector growth rate was $-0.10 \%$. The contribution to nominal GDP in Q2 2022 stood at $4.95 \%$, relative to $5.05 \%$ recorded in the second quarter of 2021 and higher than the $4.92 \%$ accounted for in the first quarter of 2022.

Real GDP growth recorded in the sector for the second quarter of 2022 stood at $4.42 \%$, higher than the growth recorded in the second quarter of 2021 by $0.57 \%$ points, and lower by $0.02 \%$ points relative to Q1 2022. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -0.74\% in the second quarter of 2022. It contributed $5.33 \%$ to real GDP in Q2 2022, higher than the $5.28 \%$ it recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2021.

## Finance and Insurance

The Finance and Insurance Sector consists of the two subsectors, Financial Institutions and Insurance, which accounted for $89.10 \%$ and $10.90 \%$ of the sector respectively in real terms in Q2 2022.

As a whole, the sector grew at $29.90 \%$ in nominal terms (year-on-year), with the growth rate of Financial Institutions at $31.63 \%$ and $17.28 \%$ growth rate recorded for Insurance. The overall rate was higher than that of Q2 2021 by $31.76 \%$ points and lower by $2.39 \%$ points than the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter growth was $-5.19 \%$. The sector's contribution to the overall nominal GDP was $3.63 \%$ in Q2 2022, higher than the $3.21 \%$ it represented a year previous, and lower than the contribution of $3.80 \%$ it made in the preceding quarter.

Growth in this sector in real terms totaled $18.48 \%$, higher by $20.96 \%$ points from the rate recorded in the 2021 second quarter and down by $4.76 \%$ points from the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter growth in real terms stood at $-5.96 \%$. The contribution of Finance and Insurance to real GDP totaled $4.25 \%$, higher than the contribution of $3.72 \%$ recorded in the second quarter of 2021 by $0.54 \%$ points, and lower than $4.51 \%$ recorded in Q1 2022 by $0.25 \%$ points.

## Professional, Scientific and Technical Services

In second quarter 2022, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services recorded a nominal growth of $11.79 \%$ (year-on-year), which is $9.87 \%$ points higher than Q2 2021, and $2.46 \%$ points higher than the rate recorded in Q1 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by $-5.40 \%$. The contribution of Professional, Scientific and Technical Services to nominal GDP was 2.59\% in Q2 2022, down from the 2.67\% contribution in Q2 2021 and down from the 2.72\% recorded in Q1 2022.

Real growth in the sector was recorded at $1.96 \%$ in Q2 2022, an increase of $0.68 \%$ points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2021, and $0.11 \%$ points higher than that of Q1 2022. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by -6.16\% in Q2 2022. Professional, Scientific and Technical Services contributed $3.04 \%$ to aggregate GDP in Q2 2022, lower than the $3.09 \%$ it contributed in Q2 2021 and lower than 3.23\% recorded in Q1 2022.

## Administrative and Support Services

In nominal terms, the Administrative and Support Services sector grew by $11.91 \%$ (year-on-year) in Q2 2022, higher by $6.45 \%$ points compared to the second quarter of 2021 and higher by $0.56 \%$ points than the growth rate in the previous quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter, the growth rate in the sector was $5.39 \%$ in Q2 2022. The contribution of Administrative and Support Services to nominal GDP was $0.02 \%$ in Q2 2022, relatively the same as the $0.02 \%$ it contributed in the same period in 2021 and the $0.02 \%$ it contributed in the preceding quarter.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of $2.06 \%$ (year-on-year), a decrease of $2.73 \%$ points from the corresponding quarter of 2021 , and a decrease of $1.66 \%$ points from the rate recorded in Q1 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by $4.54 \%$ in Q2 2022. The sector's contribution to real GDP was $0.02 \%$ in the 2022 second quarter, roughly unchanged from the corresponding quarter in the 2021 and 2022 first quarters.

## Public Administration

In nominal terms, the Public Administration sector grew by $11.84 \%$ in Q2 2022, higher by $12.90 \%$ points from the corresponding quarter of 2021 and higher by $2.43 \%$ points relative to Q1 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by $33.52 \%$. The contribution of Public Administration to Nominal GDP stood at $1.85 \%$ in Q2 2022, lower than the $1.90 \%$ recorded in Q2 2021 by $0.05 \%$ points and higher than the $1.38 \%$ recorded in Q1 2022 by $0.47 \%$ points.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 2.01\% (year-on-year) in Q2 2022, higher by $3.69 \%$ points and higher by $0.08 \%$ points from the Q2 2021 rate and the Q1 2022 rate respectively. On Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by $32.44 \%$ in Q2 2022. The contribution of Public Administration to Real GDP stood at 2.17\% in Q2 2022, lower compared to $2.21 \%$ in Q2 2021 and higher than 1.63\% in Q1 2022.

## Education

Nominal growth in the Education sector in the second quarter of 2022 was $6.23 \%$ (year-on-year), down by $0.74 \%$ points from the growth of $6.97 \%$ reported in the corresponding quarter of 2021, and down by $1.66 \%$ points when compared to Q1 2022 growth rate of $7.88 \%$. Quarter-on-Quarter growth rate was -29.91\%. The contribution of Education to nominal GDP in Q2 2022 was 1.17\%; down from 1.27\% estimated in Q2 2021 and yet down from 1.66\% in Q1 2022.

Real growth in Education year-on-year stood at $1.16 \%$ in Q2 2022; an increase of $0.52 \%$ points from the corresponding quarter of 2021 which was estimated at $0.63 \%$. When compared with the previous quarter's rate of $1.87 \%$, the sector's growth decreased by $0.72 \%$ points. The Sector contributed $1.34 \%$ to total real GDP in Q2 2022 which was lower than the $1.37 \%$ reported for the corresponding Quarter in 2021 and lower than the 1.92\% recorded in Q1 2022.

## Human Health and Social Services

The year-on-year growth rate for Human Health and Social Services in nominal terms was $13.58 \%$, up relative to the growth rate of $11.12 \%$ reported in the same quarter of 2021 by $2.46 \%$ points and up by $0.23 \%$ points compared to Q1 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter growth was $9.71 \%$. The contribution to nominal GDP was $0.67 \%$ in Q2 2022, slightly lower than the $0.68 \%$ recorded in Q2 2021 and up from the 0.60\% recorded in Q1 2022.

Real GDP growth of Human Health and Social Services for Q2 2022 stood at 2.23\% (year-on-year) compared to $4.92 \%$ for the corresponding period of 2021 which shows a fall of $2.69 \%$ points. The growth in Q2 2022 was also lower than the growth recorded in Q1 2022 by $3.68 \%$ points. Quarter-on-Quarter, this sector grew by 4.18\%. The contribution of Human Health and Social Services to real GDP was $0.76 \%$ in Q2 2022, relatively lower than the figure recorded in Q2 2021 and up from the $0.73 \%$ recorded for the preceding quarter.

## Other Services

In nominal terms, Other Services grew by $12.99 \%$ (year-on-year) in Q2 2022. This growth rate was higher than the $1.27 \%$ growth rate recorded in the same quarter of the previous year and higher than the growth rate of $10.71 \%$ in Q1 2022 by $11.71 \%$ points and $2.27 \%$ points respectively. Quarter-on-Quarter growth was $-32.04 \%$. This sector contributed $2.34 \%$ to the aggregate nominal GDP in Q2 2022, lower than the $2.38 \%$ it contributed in the same period of the previous year and lower than the $3.41 \%$ it contributed in the preceding quarter.

Other Services' real GDP grew by 3.05\% (year-on-year) in Q2 2022. This growth was higher by 2.41\% points than the growth recorded in the same period of the previous year and lower by $0.09 \%$ points from Q1 2022. Quarter-on-Quarter growth was $-32.59 \%$. The sector contributed $2.74 \%$ to real GDP in Q2 2022, slightly lower than the $2.75 \%$ recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2021 and lower than the 4.05\% recorded in Q1 2022.

## Methodological Notes

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are an integrated system of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation on a quarterly basis. They provide a picture of the current economic status of an economy on a more frequent basis than Annual National Accounts (ANA). In providing a reasonable level of detailed information about the economy, QNA allows the government to regularly assess, analyze and monitor economic developments.

In line with international standards outlined under the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSTATS), four major methodological pillars underpin GDP compilation in Nigeria:

1. The System of National Accounts (SNA 2008 version): The internationally agreed standard of recommendations as to how to compile measures of economic activity.
2. The International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC Revision 4.0): This is the international reference for the classification of productive activities. Its main purpose is to provide a set of activity categories that can be used for the collection and reporting of statistics according to such activities.
3. The Central Product Classification (CPC version 2): The classification is based on the physical characteristics of goods or on the nature of services rendered. The CPC covers products that are output of economic activities.
Data for this analysis were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS), tax receipts from the Federal Inland Revenue Service, and other administrative sources such as the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation. The series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP under 46 activities at current and constant (2010) prices.

Using the above data and standards, GDP is computed as gross output minus intermediate consumption. Both gross output and intermediate consumption are detailed below for each activity:

## 1. AGRICULTURE

Under Section A, Division 01-03 of ISIC rev 4, Agriculture is divided into four main activities.

### 1.1 CROP PRODUCTION

Section A, Division 01 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Quantities produced multiplied by farm gate price, less losses (wastages).
Intermediate consumption: Seeds, fertilizer, pesticides, hire of farm implements and simple farm tools that are used up in one farming season.

### 1.2 LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION

Section A, Division 01 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output is calculated using the following Live animals and their produce + imports = animals slaughtered and their produce-animals which died of natural causes +exports + change in animal stock.
Intermediate Consumption: Value of animal feeds as input in the production of livestock and livestock products (such as broiler starter concentrate, breeder concentrate, ground cake, guinea corn etc.)

### 1.3 FORESTRY

Section A, Division 02 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Value and quantity of timbers of various types (firewood, charcoal, uncultivated materials gathered). Other forest products obtained using expenditure approach. Sawn-logs, and other wood products categories are obtained using the production method, whereby, the quantity of logs produced is multiplied by the price per cubic of log.
Intermediate consumption: Expenditure on seeds and sapling, fuel oils, lubricants, feed, hand tools and spare parts, payments for contract work and other services.

### 1.4 FISHING

Section A, Division 03 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Measured by multiplying quantity in kilogram by the average price to obtain the value of production.
Intermediate consumption: Intermediate consumption here is captured according to expenditure on fingerlings, nets, feeds and other operating expenses.

## 2. MINING AND QUARRYING

Section B, Division 05-09 of ISIC Rev 4.0

### 2.1 CRUDE PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS

Section B, Division 06 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Quantity of crude petroleum produced (barrels) and Natural gas in million cubic feet (mcf) multiplied by the average price in domestic currency (equivalent of the price in dollar during the accounting period).
Intermediate Consumption: Includes purchase of consultancy services, Transportation, Electricity Bills, Water bills, Cost of Fuel used, Minor Repairs and Maintenance, Medical expense to staff, License \& Registration fees, Travelling allowance, Staff Uniform, Rents on machinery \& buildings, Spare Parts etc.

### 2.2 COAL MINING

Section B, Division 05 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price.
Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and Local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing use at work, rents on machinery \& buildings, Spare Parts etc.

### 2.3 METAL ORES

Section B, Division 07 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price
Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and Local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing used at work, rents on machinery \& buildings, Spare Parts etc.

### 2.4 QUARRYING AND OTHER MINING

Section B, Division 08 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price
Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing used at work, rents on machinery \& buildings, Spare Parts etc.

## 3. MANUFACTURING

Section C, Division 10-33 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross output = Revenue from sales of goods + Revenue from sales of goods bought for resale (trade margin) + Revenue from rendering services to other +Closing stock of finished goods -Opening stock of finished goods + Closing stock of work-in-progress -Opening stock of work-in-progress
Intermediate consumption = Purchases of raw materials and supplies + Purchases of goods bought for resale + Purchases of packaging materials +Fuels and lubricants +Electricity +Water and Sewerage +Repair and Maintenance +Freight charges and transport +Closing stock of raw materials and supplies - Opening stock of raw materials and supplies +Insurance premium +All other costs and expenses for goods and services

## 4. ELECTRICITY, GAS, STEAM AND AIR CONDITIONING SUPPLY

Section D, Division 35 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross Output: The value of output is the amount of gas and electricity paid for. Hence, value added is the output less intermediate consumption.
Intermediate Consumption=other cost of sales + Indirect expenses

## 5. WATER SUPPLY, SEWERAGE, WASTE MANAGEMENT AND REMEDIATION

Section E, Division 36 of ISIC Rev. 4
Gross output = Water revenue + Sewage revenue + New connections
Intermediate Consumption=other cost of sales + Indirect expenses

## 6. TRADE

Section G, Divisions 45 to 47 of ISIC Rev. 4.
Gross Output: This is equal to the trade margin, i.e. the difference between the revenue of goods sold and the value of the goods purchased for resale.
Intermediate Consumption: Goods and services needed to run the trading establishment, such as packaging materials, electricity, office supplies, and rentals.

## 7. CONSTRUCTION

Section F, Division 41 to 43 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross Output: Value of work done and other incomes.
Intermediate Consumption: This comprises cement, blocks, metals/iron bars, sand, stone, wood, gravel, other construction inputs, and cost of fuel used by generator, water bills and expenses on internet services/telephone/postage bills during the construction period.

## 8. ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD SERVICES

Section I, Division 55 to 56 of ISIC Rev. 4.
Gross Output: Income generated from Accommodation, Catering, Restaurants, Beverage Service activities and Other income
Intermediate Consumption includes expenses incurred in running the businesses.

## 9. TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE

This industry is broadly categorized under ISIC Rev. 4, Section H, division 49-53. The sector is divided into 6 sub-economic activities.

### 9.1 ROAD TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 49 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: The output of road transport is the revenue generated for the period under consideration.
Intermediate Consumption: Intermediate consumption consists of fuels and lubricants used
electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

### 9.2 RAIL TRANSPORT AND PIPELINES

Section H, Division 49 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Receipts from passengers, goods traffic and subventions from Federal Government. The Petroleum Pipeline Product income is from the transportation of the petroleum products and crude oil to designated depots and refineries in Nigeria.
Intermediate Consumption: This consists of the summation of all expenses incurred in the production process such as fuels and lubricants used, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

### 9.3 WATER TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 50 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Receipts from passengers and goods traffic.
Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

### 9.4 AIR TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 51 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Receipts from passengers and Cargoes (goods traffic).
Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals, Spare parts, Consultancy, Audit fees

### 9.5 TRANSPORT SERVICES

Section H, Division 52 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Receipts from services for storage and transportation activities.
Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, transportation cost, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

### 9.6 POST AND COURIER SERVICES

Section H, Division 53 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Receipts from services rendered on number of mails and parcels handled.
Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, transportation costs, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

## 10. INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION

Categorized under ISIC Rev. 4, Section J, Division 58-63, the sector is divided into 4 economic activities:

### 10.1 TELECOMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION SERVICES

Section J, Division 61 to 63 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross Output: Revenue from telephone, telex, Facsimile, telegraph, and other income from satellite and internet services.
Intermediate consumption: Transit fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance and other expenses.

### 10.2 PUBLISHING

Section J, Division 58 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Revenue from publishing services.
Intermediate consumption: This includes details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs etc.

### 10.3 MOTION PICTURE AND SOUND RECORDING

Section J, Division 59 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross Output: Revenue generated/total sales from the number of movies and sound recordings produced including revenue generated from TV rights, royalties and fees.
Intermediate consumption: Detail on the cost structure of operating firms including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance, and other administrative expenses.

### 10.4 BROADCASTING

Section J, Division 60 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Public corporation data derived from Accountants General's reports, while the private component relies on revenue generated from services rendered e.g. advertisement.
Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure of market participants which include transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance

## 11. ARTS ENTERTAINMENT AND RECREATION

Section R, Division 90-93 of ISIC Rev 4.
Gross Output: Revenue generated was estimated in two categories: one as a market output and the second as non-market output (public establishments)
Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure were obtained from the financial reports of firms.

## 12. FINANCE AND INSURANCE SERVICES

Section k, Division 64-66 of ISIC Rev 4, Finance and Insurance Services is divided into two (2) sectors.

### 12.1 FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Section K, Division 64 of ISIC Rev 4
Gross Output: Gross output for financial services are measured by Financial Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM).
Gross Output = Implicit service charges (FISIM) +Explicit service changes.
Intermediate Consumption: Details of the cost structure are extracted from the data supplied such as; Currency Issue Expenses, Administrative Expenses, Repairs and Maintenance, Consultancy Fees, Bank Charges, Audit fees, Directors related expenses

### 12.2. INSURANCE

Section K, Division 65 of ISIC Rev 4

## Gross Output:

The Output of life insurance: Output = Actual premiums earned + Plus Premium supplements Benefits due -Minus Increases (plus decreases) in life insurance technical reserves
Output of non-life (General) insurance: Output = Actual premiums earned + Premium supplements - Adjusted claims incurred

Output of funded pension fund: Output = Actual pension contributions + Supplementary contributions -Benefits due +Plus Change in the actuarial reserves + Property income

Intermediate consumption: consists of the cost structure (operating expenses) from the annual reports of institutions.

Gross Output: Sum of revenues receivable for the services rendered.
Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

## 15. ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUPPORT SERVICES

Section N, Division 77-82 of ISIC RE 4.
Gross Output: Sum of fees and commissions receivable for the services rendered.
Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

## 16. PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

Section O, Division 48 of ISIC Rev. 4
Gross output Basic = Intermediate consumption (Less commodity sales and fees) +Compensation of employees+ Consumption of fixed capital +Other taxes less subsidies on production.

## 17. EDUCATION

Section P, division 85 of ISIC Rev. 4.
Gross Output: Consists of government production, which is a non-market service offered without charge or at a price not economically significant, and private production, offered at the market price.
