EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Selected Food Price Watch for October 2022 shows that the average price of 1kg onion bulb on a year-on-year basis, rose by 32.56% from the value recorded in October 2021 (N306.07) to N405.72 in October 2022. On a month-on-month basis, it increased to N405.72 in October 2022 from N397.18 in September 2022 indicating a 2.15% increase. The average price of 1kg rice (local sold loose) increased on a year-on-year basis by 17.45% from N415.03 in October 2021 to N487.47 in October 2022. On a month-on-month basis, the average price of this item increased by 3.40% in October 2022.


The average price of 1kg of Tomato rose on a year-on-year basis by 30.79% from N347.47 in October 2021 to N454.46 in October 2022. Also, on a month-on-month basis, it increases to 2.10% from N445.12 in September 2022. Similarly, the average price of 1kg bean (sold lose) rose by 17.95% on a year-on-year basis from N478.76 in October 2021 to N564.69 in October 2022.

In addition, the average price of Palm oil: (1 bottle, specify bottle) increased by 33.22% from N727.21 in October 2021 to N968.76 in October 2022. It also grew by 4.47% on a month-onmonth basis. In the same vein, the average price of Vegetable oil (1 bottle, specify bottle) stood at N1,106.08 in October 2022, showing an increase of 33.99% from N825.46 in October 2021. On a month-on-month basis, it rose by 2.81% from N1,075.89 in September 2022. At the state level, the highest average price of rice (local sold loose) was recorded in Rivers with N630.66, while the lowest was recorded in Jigawa with N381.54. Ebonyi recorded the highest average price of beans (brown, sold loose) with N848.74, while the lowest was reported in Plateau with N360.03. In addition, Abia recorded the highest price of Vegetable oil (1 bottle, specify bottle) at N1,484.31, while Benue recorded the lowest at N650.89.

Analysis by zone showed that the average price of 1kg onion bulb was higher in the South-South and South-East with N670.63 and N538.31 respectively, while the lowest was recorded in the North-East with N212.83. The South-South recorded the highest average price of 1kg rice (local sold loose) with N545.03, followed by the South-West with N519.53, while the lowest was recorded in the North-West with N435.06. Similarly, South-East recorded the highest average price of Palm oil: (1 bottle, specify bottle) with N1,101.04, followed by the South-West with N742.62.


- NORTH EAST











METHODOLOGY

Fieldwork is done solely by over 700 NBS Staff in all States of the federation supported by supervisors who are monitored by internal and external observers.

Prices are collected across all the 774 local governments across all States and the FCT from over 10,000 respondents and locations and reflect actual prices households state they actually bought those items.

The average of all these prices is then reported for each state and the average for the country is the average for the state.

NBS audit team subsequently conducts randomly selected verification of prices recorded.
