SECTION ONE

CLIMATOLOGY

This section contains data on weather conditions for years 2007 and 2008 in Ondo State. In both years, readings of air temperature and relative humidity were taken two times in a day at 10am and at 4pm local time.

In the year 2007, the average monthly air temperature at 10am was 20.9°C with a standard deviation of 3.16°C while the average air temperature at 4pm was 32.1°C with a standard deviation of 5.79°C . The average monthly air temperature taken at 10am ranges from 21.8°C in October to 18.9°C in the month of January. At 4 pm, the monthly average air temperature ranges from 34.1°C in the month of November to 29.1°C in July. The highest relative humidity of 90% at 10am was recorded in September 2007 while the lowest of 66.5% was recorded in the month of January. The highest relative humidity at 4pm was 89.5%, recorded in September while the lowest of 64.2% was recorded in January. Out of 365 days in the year, 95 days of rainfall with a total rainfall of 1232.6mm was recorded giving an average of 13mm rainfall per month. The highest rainfall of 201.4 mm was recorded in July while January has the lowest rainfall of 4.4 mm.

In year 2008, the average monthly air temperature at 10am was 21.8°C with a standard deviation of 3.5°C while the average monthly air temperature at 4pm for the year was 31.7°C with a standard deviation of 5.6°C . The average monthly air temperature at 10am ranges from 23.5°C in the month of December to 19.8°C in January. The highest relative humidity of 88.6% taken at 10am was recorded in the month of November while the lowest of 65.3% was recorded in the month of January. The highest relative humidity at 4pm was 80.6% in August while the lowest of 61.2% was recorded in the month of January. The highest rainfall of 356.5 mm was recorded in the month of July while the least was in January with zero rainfall. Out of 365 days in the year, 95 days of rainfall with total rain of 1939.3mm was recorded.

This gives an average of 16.16mm rainfall per month as against 13mm recorded per month in 2007.

The comparison between years 2007 and 2008 shows that there was more rainfall and slightly higher relative humidity at 10am in year 2008 while relative humidity at 4pm was higher in 2007.

SECTION TWO

FISHERY

This section contains information on number of fish farmers and type of ownership of fish ponds, with their locations in each Local Government Area in the state in year 2007.

Table 2.1 shows that the total number of registered fish farmers recorded in the State for the year was 284.

Table 2.2 reveals that the total number of fish ponds recorded in the state was 909 out of which private individuals have 696 (or 76.6%), Companies have 89 (or 9.8%), Educational institutions have 59 (or 6.5%). The others accounted for the balance. The record also shows that Akure South Local Government Area has the highest number of fish ponds of 226 (or 24.9%) while Irele Local Government Area has the lowest number of 2 (or 0.2%) out of the total fish ponds recorded in the State.

SECTION THREE

LIVESTOCK

This section contains information on livestock slaughtered in approved slaughter slabs in each Local Government Area of the state in the two years under review.

Tables 3.5 is the comparative analysis of livestock slaughtered in both years. The total number of animals slaughtered in 2007 was 26,826 out of which 19,703 (73%) were cattle, 7041 (26%) were goats and pigs were 325 (1%).

In year 2008, the total number of animals slaughtered was 25,491, a decrease of 1,335 or 4.98% compared with the figure recorded in year 2007. The record also shows that Akure South Local Government Area expectedly recorded the highest number of livestock slaughtered in both years.

The details of animals treated in Veterinary clinics by zone in 2007 is contained in table 3.6, From the record, it could be observed that Owo zone recorded the highest number of animals treated. The zone comprises Owo, Ifon, Idoani, Ikare, Oka, Isua, Oke-Agbe and Oba – Akoko. In 2008, the prime position went to Ondo zone. The zone comprises Ondo, Okitipupa, Ore and Ile-oluji. The total number of animals treated in the state was 13,342 in 2007 and 11,133 in 2008. The purpose of Inspection and treatment of animals is to ensure the delivery of hygienic meat to the people to improve public health.

SECTION FOUR

FORESTRY

This section gives detailed information on forestry in year 2008.

Table 4.1 shows the types of forestry reserves in square kilometres. Out of 3076.16qkm forestry reserve, the high forest accounted for the highest portion of 2834.67sq km representing 92.2%, savannah forest, 6.3% and Mangrove forest, 1.5%. The area encroached is 1391.63, about 45.3% of the total area. This calls for necessary measures by the state government to address the situation.

Tables 4.2 and 4.3 show monthly revenue collected on forestry between 2007 and 2008 which are ₦144,237,029 and ₦177,120,476.50 respectively. The highest monthly revenue of ₦18,949,425.00 (13.2%) in 2007, was recorded in February while highest monthly revenue of ₦29,181,905(16.5%) in the year 2008, was recorded in January. The tables also reveal that Owo local Government Area recorded the highest revenue of ₦29,474,578 in 2007 and Akure North Local Government Area recorded the highest of ₦32,429,225 in 2008.

Tables 4.4 and 4.5 show the summary of the revenue on quarterly basis in 2007 and 2008. The highest revenues were recorded in first quarter in both years.





SECTION FIVE

PRODUCE

This section focuses on major Agricultural Produce in the State in 2007 and 2008. The major produce are Cocoa, Palm kernel, Coffee, Cashew and Rubber.

Tables 5.1-5.12 provide information on tonnage/revenue generated from graded produce on monthly basis. Cocoa has the highest number of tonnage in both years. Also output of Cocoa and Palm kernel were higher in 2008 compared to 2007. In addition, Idanre local government area accounted for the highest tonnage on graded Cocoa in the two years, while Ondo west local government area accounted for the highest number of Palm kernel output in both years.

SECTION SIX

FARM SETTLEMENTS

Table 6.1 shows the classification of farm settlements in the state by type and the total number of settlers for years 2007 and 2008. From the table, the size of settlement in year 2007 was 6,953 hectares, out of which 3,460 hectares were cultivated. In year 2008, the size of settlement was 8,660 hectares out of which 3,563.2 was cultivated. The total number of settlers was 294 in both years. Onisere farm settlement in Idanre local government area recorded the highest number of 95 settlers.
