## **FARMGATE PRICES OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS**

### **PROVISIONAL**

#### **1.0. INTRODUCTION**

Farm gate Price is defined as the price at which the producer (farmer) sells his/her farm produce (crop) at the farm or nearest market outlet to the farm, excluding the middlemen. This price is valued per kilogram (or litre) in naira. The farmgate price is to gauge the actual amount that comes to the farmer from the sales of the farm produce.

The data is an extract from the Annual survey on Socio-Economic Activities conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) in collaboration with Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) and Nigerian Communication Commission (NCC) ; and National Exportable Crops Survey also conducted by NBS in collaboration with Central Bank of Nigeria, Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (FMA&RD) and Federal Ministry of Trade and Investment (FMT&I).

#### **2.0. METHODOLOGY**

##### **2.1. Sampling Frame**

The sampling frame was the list of EAs demarcated by the National Population Commission for the 2006 Population and Housing Census.

##### **2.2. Sample Design for NBS/CBN/NCC Collaborative Survey on Socio-Economic Activities in Nigeria.**

For each state, 60 EAs were systematically selected in ratio 4:3:2:1 for Crop, Livestock, Poultry and Fishing and vice-versa depending on the intensity of farming activities.

For example, if in a particular state the order of intensity for Farming activities was 4 (Crop), 3 (Livestock), 2 (Poultry) and 1 (Fishing); then the EAs were assigned as follows: 24 Crop EAs , 18 Livestock EAs, 12 Poultry EAs and 6 Fishing EAs.

However if, in the state, only 3 farming activities were obtainable, the distribution was at the ratio 5:3:2 depending on the intensity of the farming activities.

For example, if in a particular state the order of intensity for Farming activities was 5 (Crop), 3 (Livestock), and 2 (Poultry) then the EAs were assigned as follows: 30 Crop EAs , 18 Livestock EAs, 12 Poultry EAs. On the other hand,

if, in a state, only 2 farming activities were obtainable, the distribution was at the ratio 6:4 depending on the intensity of the farming activities,

then the EAs were assigned as follows: 36 Crop EAs , 24 Livestock EAs.

However if, in the state, only 1 farming activity was obtainable, then all 60 EAs were covered for the only farming activity.

#### **2.2.1. Second Stage Selection: Selection of Households**

In each of the 60 EAs selected per state, 16 HHs were selected per EA in the ratio 5,5,3,3 for interview depending on the order of intensity.

That is, select 5 HHs for first major activity, 5 HHs for 2<sup>nd</sup> major, 3 HHs for 3<sup>rd</sup> major and 3 HHs for last, depending on the activity which is of highest intensity in the area.

If an activity was not available, its allocation share on the others to make up 16 HHs.

This gave a sample size of 960 farming households in each state.

Nationally, 35,520 farming households were canvassed.

#### **2.3. Sample Design for National Exportable Crops Survey**

A two-stage cluster sample design was adopted in each State; Enumeration Areas (EAs) formed the first stage while Households (HHs) formed the second stage.

In all, 1,920 EAs were sampled nationwide with 10 HHs selected from each EAs which brought the total number of households covered in the survey to 19,200. Where there were 10 or less farming households, no selection was required and all available households were studied.
