
3.0 FINDINGS IN SOCIO-DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

Type of Dwellings






3.2 TOILET FACILITY

Toilet Facilities





PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY MAJOR SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER (NATIONAL)





Source of Lighting


