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COMMENTS AND OBSERVATIONS

DISTRIBUTION OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

This section focuses on the distribution of educational institutions by various domains in Ondo State. Table 1 is the distribution of educational institutions by type / ownership in 2003/2004 - 2007/2008 sessions. The types of institutions are nursery/primary school, secondary school, non-formal and adult literacy centre, health training institution, technical college, college of education, college of agriculture, polytechnic and university while Ownership are private and public. The table shows that Government is the major owner/provider of educational services in the state. It was only in secondary education that the gap between number of public schools and registered private schools was not wide.

The distribution of educational institutions by senatorial district for three academic sessions, 2005/2006 – 2007/2008 is presented in Tables 2-6. The tables reveal that Ondo South has the highest number of schools while Ondo North has the lowest number of schools

The number of public primary schools in the Northern senatorial district increased from 304 in 2005/2006 to 306 in 2007/2008 while in the central, the number increased from 373 in 2005/2006 to 377 in 2007/2008 and in the South, it increased from 477 in 2005/2006 to 481 in 2007/2008. Overall, the number of Public Primary Schools in the state increased from 1154 in 2005/2006 to 1164 in 2007/2008.

The number of public secondary schools in the Northern senatorial district change from 88 in 2005/2006 to 91 Junior and 86 Senior Secondary Schools in 2007/2008. It change from 94 in 2005/2006 to 101 Junior and 95 Senior Secondary Schools in

2007/2008. In the Southern Senatorial district, it changed from 99 Secondary in 2005/2006 to 108 Junior and 98 Senior Secondary Schools in 2007/2008.

Tables 7 and 8 give the distribution of educational institutions by local government area in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions. Ondo West Local Government Area recorded the highest number of educational institutions with a figure of 166 (7.95%) while the least number of institutions was recorded in Akoko South East with 66 representing 3.16% of the total institutions recorded in the State in 2006/2007. However in 2007/2008 the number of Institutions in Akure South accounted for 8.50% of the total Institution in the State, the highest, while the least was recorded by Akure North Local Government Area.

ENROLMENT AND TURN-OUT

This section highlights student's enrolments and graduate turn-outs in public primary, secondary and tertiary institutions in the state in 2006/2007 and 2007 /2008 academic sessions.

Tables 12-17 display the enrolment in both public primary and secondary schools by gender in the two sessions under reference. The data shows that there is no gender disparity in enrolment.

The data in table 16 is the summary and trend of enrolment in public primary schools in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions. The table shows that enrolment figures increased from 873, 981 in 2006/2007 to 889732, in 2007/2008, an increment of 1.8%. Table 17 shows downward trend in enrolment in public Secondary Schools. The enrolment figures decreased from 319, 980 in 2006/2007, to 244506 in 2007/2008 a decrease of 23.59%.

Tables 20 and 21 present the enrolment data in public secondary schools by Senatorial District in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions. A total of 103,828 were enrolled in 2006/2007 as against 68014 enrolled in 2007/2008 while the enrolment figure also decreased from 10569 in 2006 /2007 to 96230 in 2007/2008 in the central senatorial district. The downward trend was also noticed in the southern senatorial district as enrolment decreased from 110405 in 2006/2007 to 82259 in 2007/2008.

Table 22 shows student enrolment in the five technical colleges in the State from 2005/2006 to 2007/2008 sessions. The data shows steady increase in enrolment. The figures increased from 1167 in 2005/2006 to 1,429 in 2007/2008. The distribution by gender shows gender biased line in favour of males in favour of males.

Table 23 shows student enrolment in the State Adult literacy centres in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions. In the basic literacy programme, enrolment decreased from 12331 in 2006/2007 to 9370 in 2007/2008. Data on enrolment into post literacy programme was not available for 2007/2008 to enable comparism.

Tables 22 and 25 are the summaries of enrolment in vocational centres by type of vocation in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008. The data shows that 511 enrolled for the available vocations in 2006/2007, while 772 enrolled in 2007/2008, an increment of 51.1%. The data also shows that out of the total enrolled in 2006/2007, 90.02 % were females while in 2007 /2008, 90.80% were females.

Table 26 shows the student enrolments in Ondo State prospect high schools in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008. The table reveals that a total of 975 enrolled in 2006/2007 session while the figure decreased to 330 in 2007/2008. There were more females than males.

Data on graduate out-turn in Technical Colleges shows that the electrical installation department turned out the highest number of graduands in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions (tables 29 and 30).

TEACHING AND NON- TEACHING STAFF

This section brings to focus the staff strength in public primary, secondary, prospect high schools, adult literacy centre technical colleges and health training institutions.

Table 32 is a breakdown of teaching staff in primary schools by academic qualifications. The table shows that out of 13812 teaching staff in 2006/2007 session, 9386 or 70% have National Certificate of Education or above, 3608 or 26% have GRD II while 818 or 6% have “other qualifications”. The total number of non-teaching staff in the schools was 1,153.

Tables 33 shows the staff strength in the adult literacy centres in 2006/2007 session. There were a total of 622 teachers out of which 341 are males and 281 are females.

Table 35 shows the staff strength in Ondo State prospect high schools in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008. The breakdown shows that in 2006/2007 there were fourteen (14) full time staff, twenty nine (29) part– time staff and eight (8) non –teaching staff. In 2007/2008, there were Six (6) full time staff, thirty (30) part time staff and nine (9) non - teaching staff.

Tables 36 and 37 highlight the distribution of academic staff in the technical colleges in 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 sessions. Government technical college Owo has the highest number of academic staff in the two sessions. In 2006/2007 ,the academic staff strength of the colleges are, government technical college, Owo, - 34, government technical college, Okitipupa, - 32, government technical college, Oka Akoko–17, government technical college Idanre- 21, and government technical college Okeigbo- 22.

The figures remained the same in 2007/2008 session. The distribution of teachers by academic qualifications in the five technical colleges shows that, 19% hold HND, 38% hold first degree, 2% have higher degree while 41% were holders of other certificates.

Table 38 and 39 show the distribution by sex of academic and non-academic staff in Technical Colleges. The distribution shows that males dominated both the academic and non –academic staff in all the colleges.

Tables 41 and 44 highlight the Student/Teacher ratio in primary schools, Health Training Institutions and Technical Colleges. The figures indicate that there was an average of 63 students to a teacher in the primary schools in 2006/2007 session while it was 29 student to a teacher in 2007/2008.

Table 43 reveals that student/teacher ratio in Health training institutions in 2005/2006,2006/2007 and 2007/2008 respectively are school of Nursing 18:1,12:1,8:1,school of Midwifery 12:1,13:1,10:1 and school of Health Technology 17:1,30:1 and 19:1

Table 44 reveals that student teacher ratio in the five technical colleges in 2006/2007 are GTC Owo (18:1), GTC Okitipupa (6:1), GTC Oka (12:1), GTC Idanre (7:1), GTC Okeigbo (6:1) in 2007/2008, the ratio are: GTC, Owo (19:1), GTC Okitipupa (9:1), GTC Oka (12:1), GTC Idanre (8:1), GTC Okeigbo (6:1)

EXAMINATION RESULTS

This section of the publication highlights the performance of Ondo State candidates in NECO and WAEC examinations.

Table 48 shows the number and percentage of Ondo State Candidates that sat for NECO Examination in 2000-2006. The analysis shows that the number of candidates with 5 Credits and above including Mathematics and English was less than 40% in each year. In 2005, only 16.0% achieved this level.

Table 49 shows detailed result by subject of the candidates that sat for WAEC in 2006.

TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS.

This section provides information on tertiary institutions in Ondo State. The institutions covered are Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko, Federal University of Technology, Akure, Adeyemi College of Education, Ondo, Federal College of Agriculture, Akure. Efforts will be intensified to include private institutions in future editions.

The scopes of coverage are pupil enrolments, graduate turn-out and staff strength.

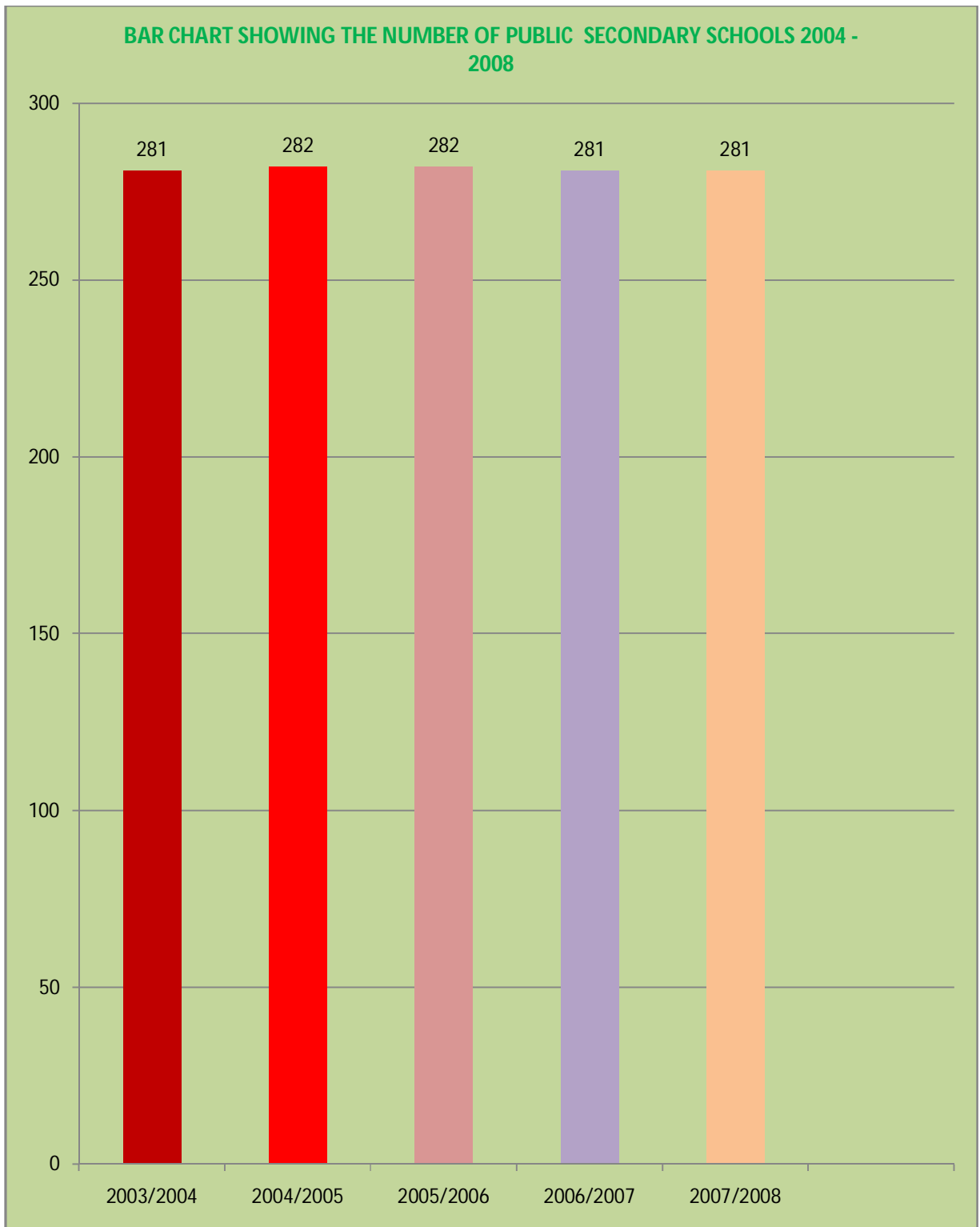

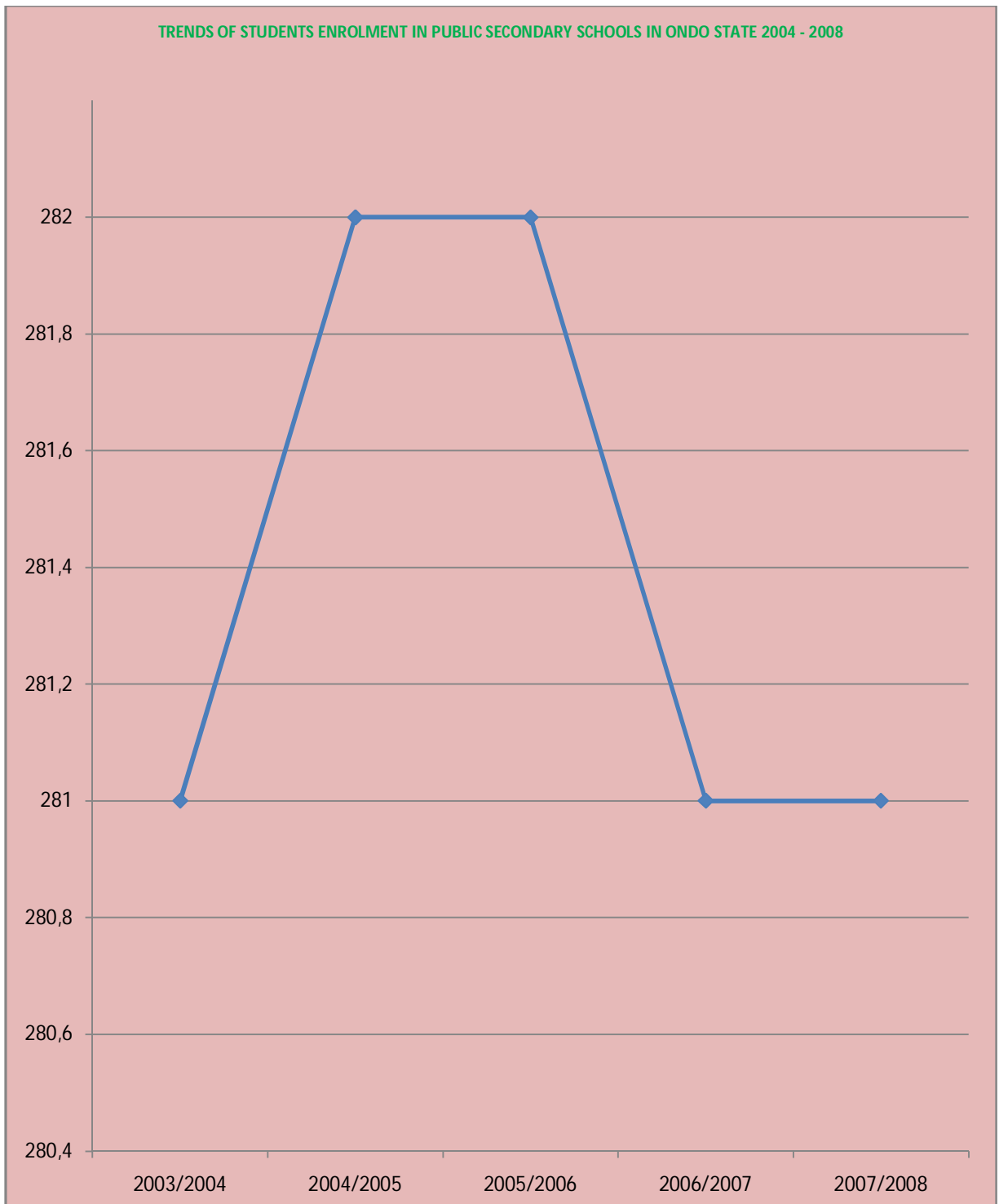

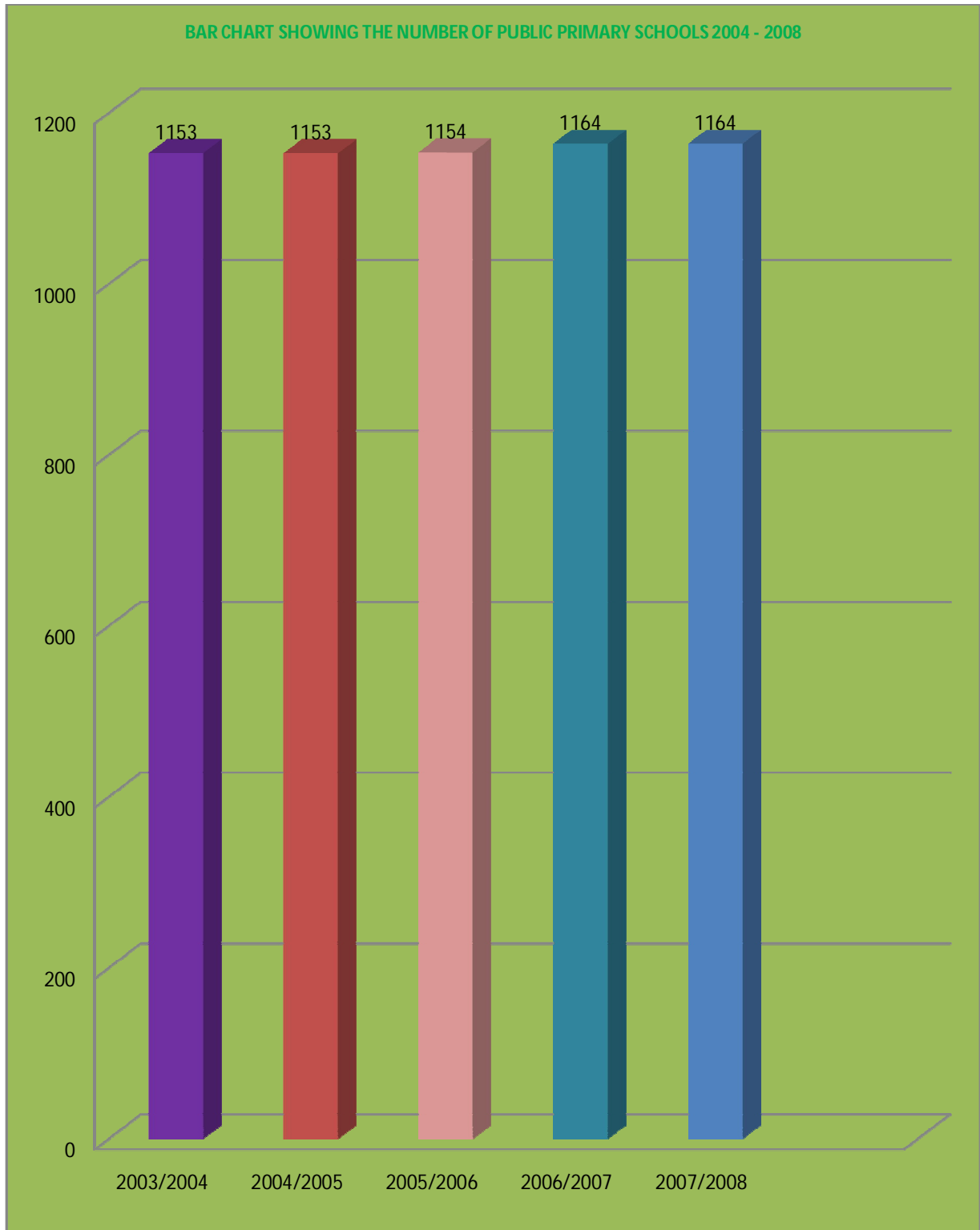

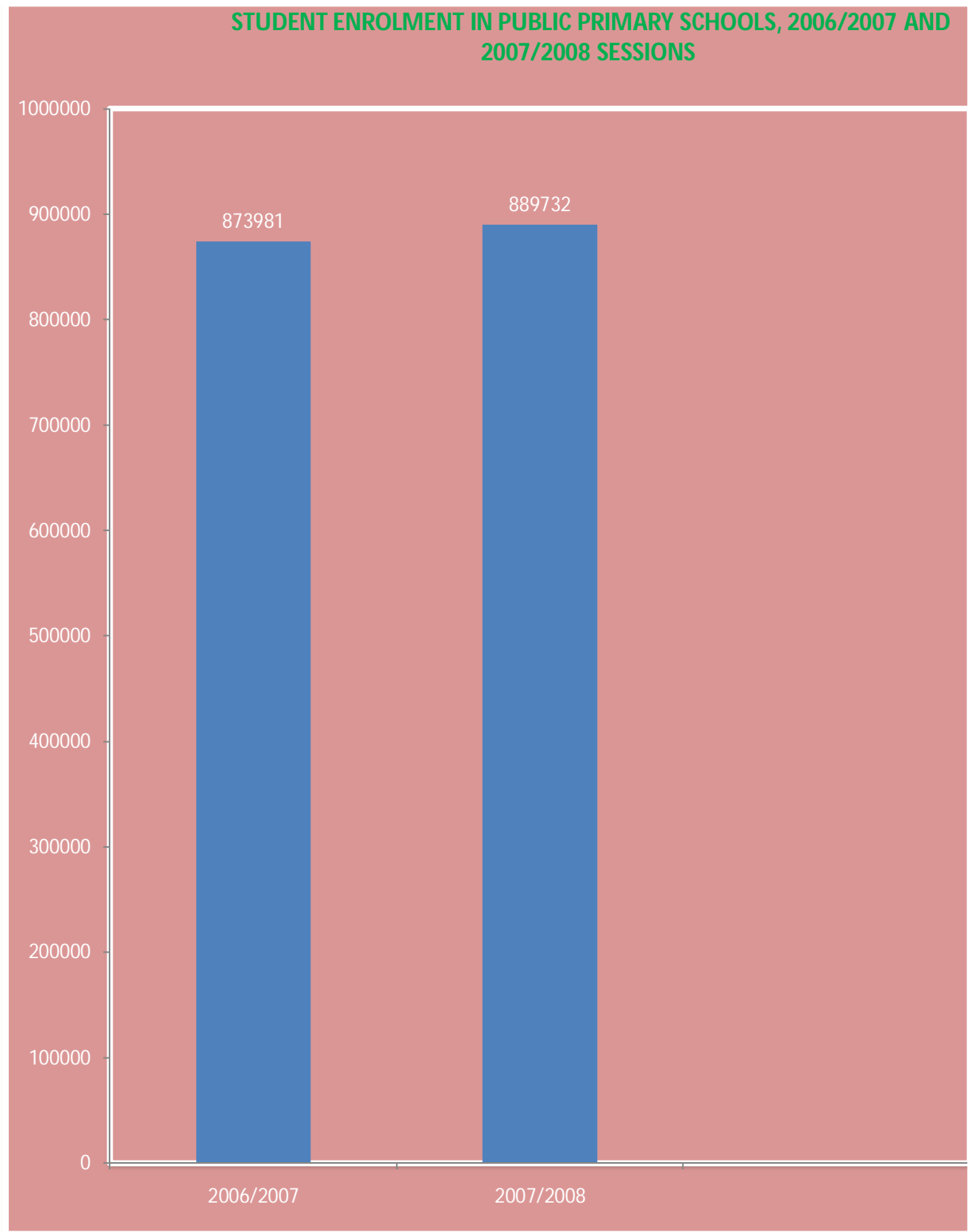

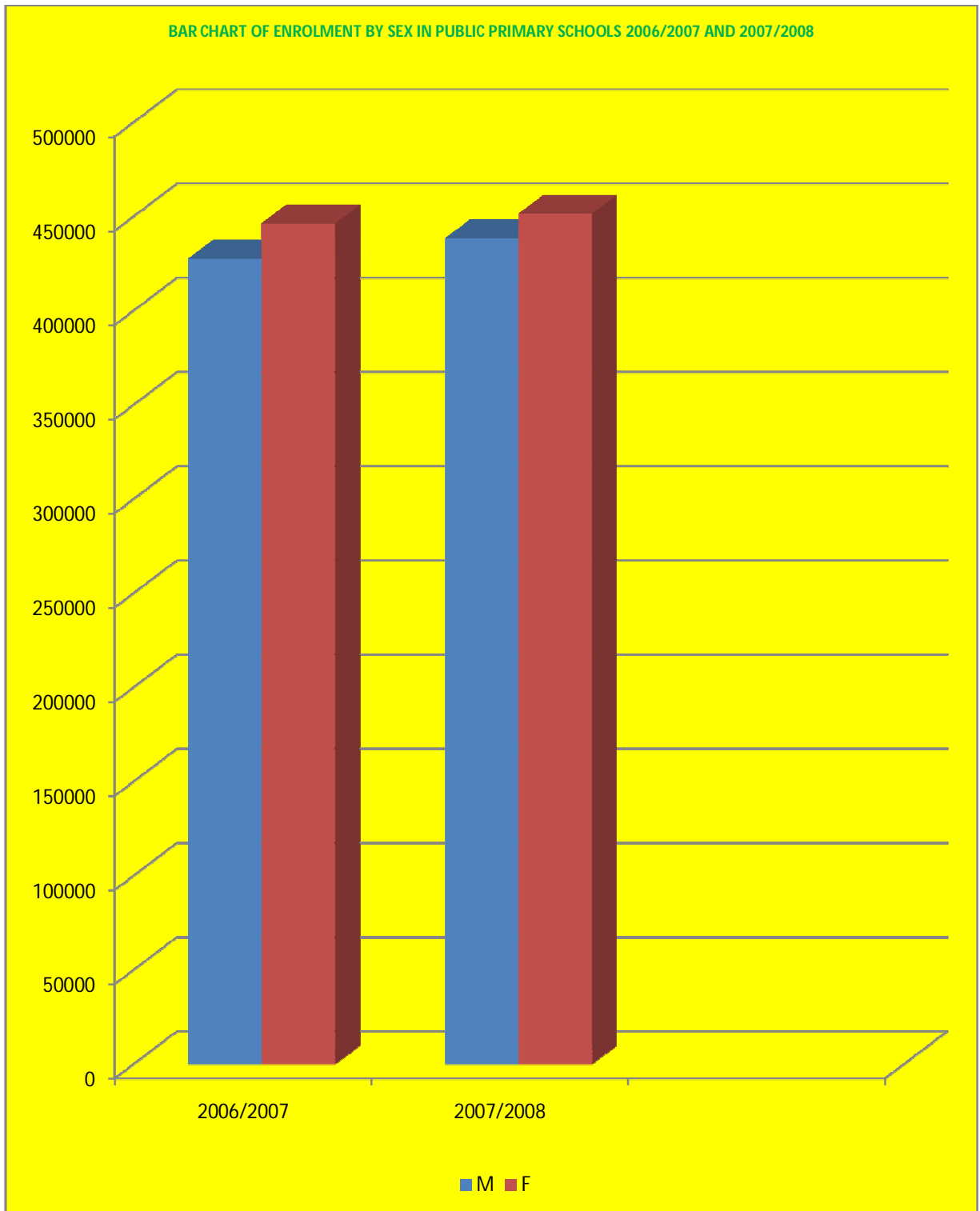

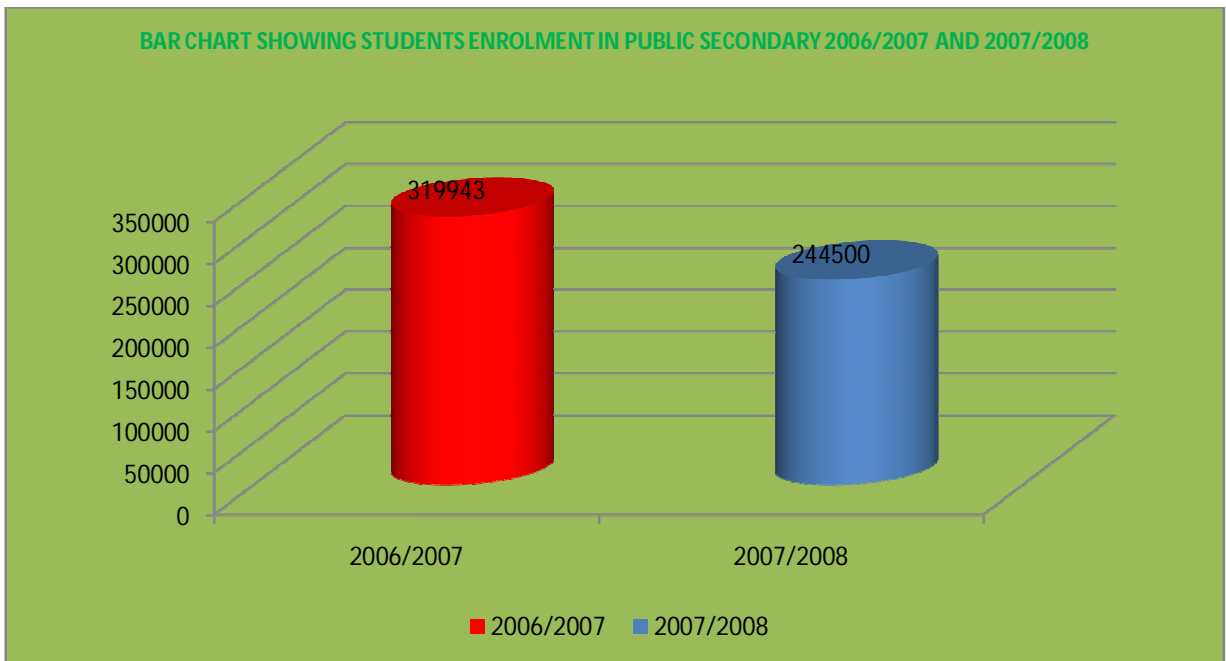

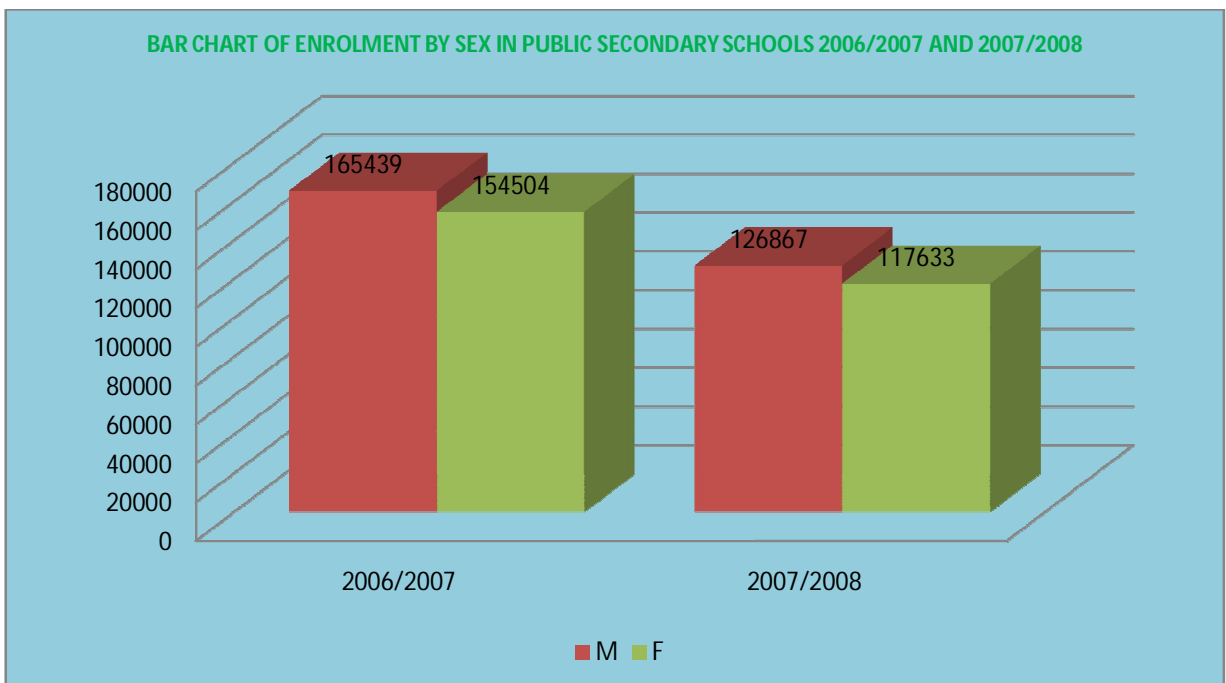

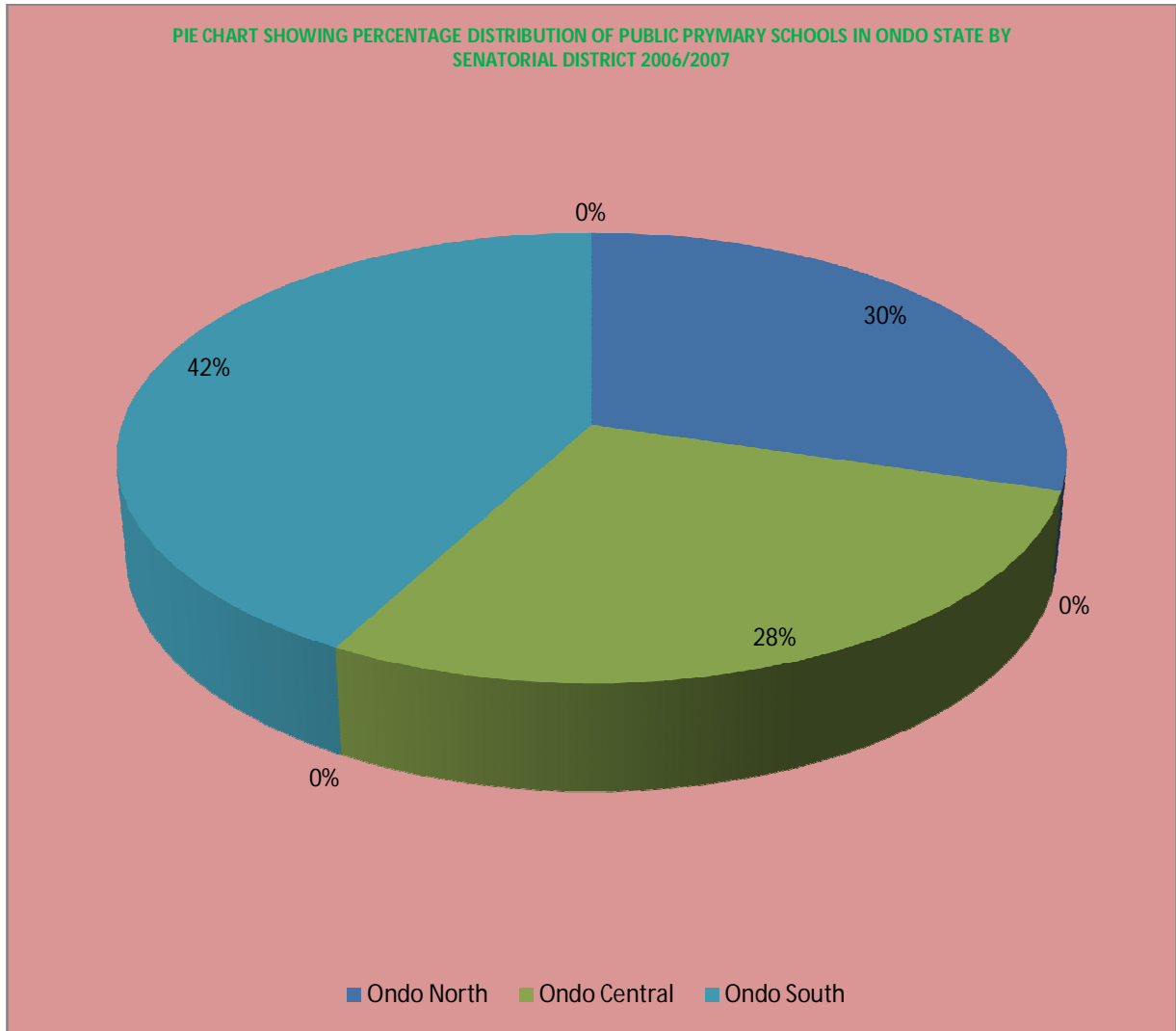

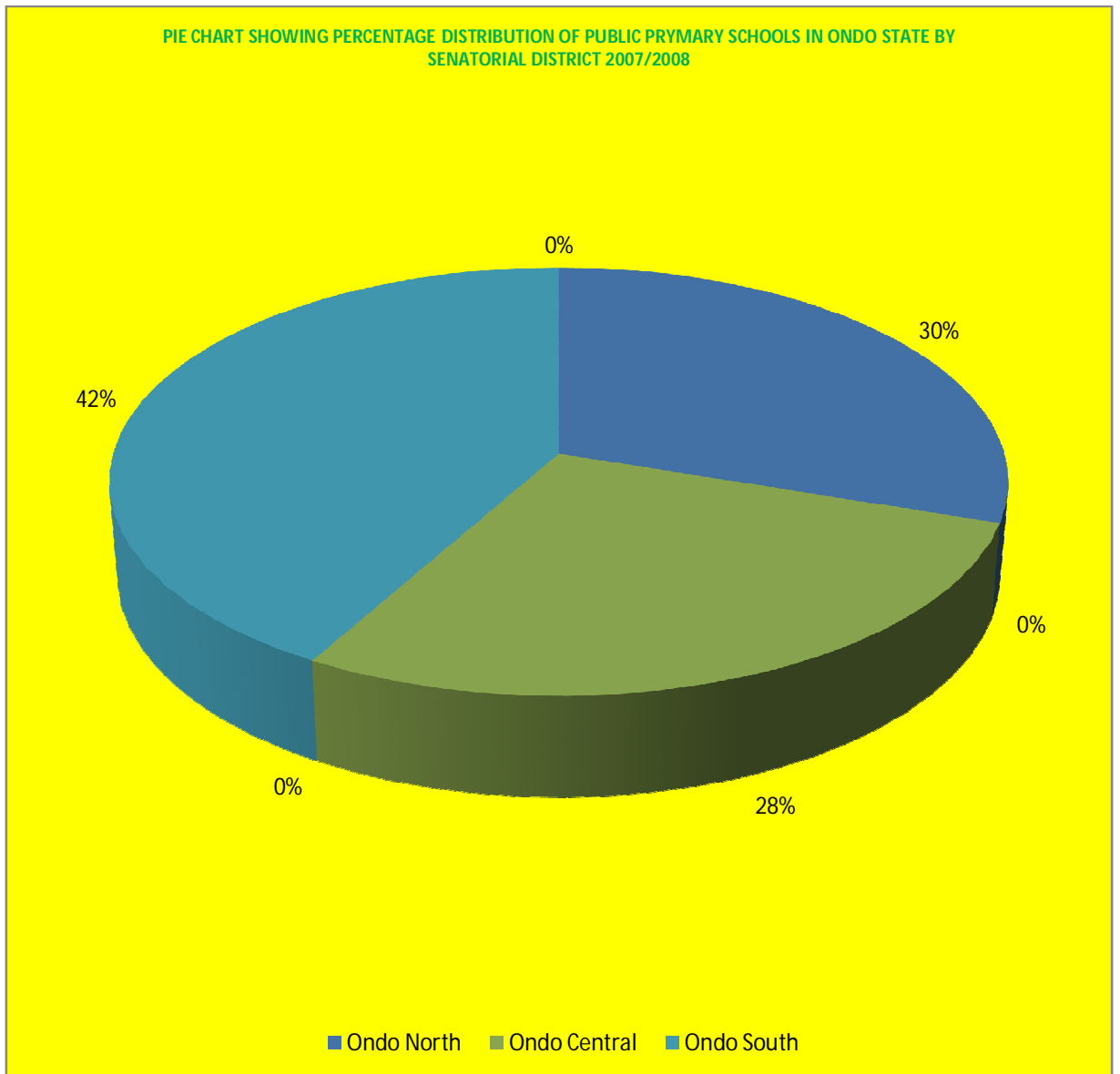

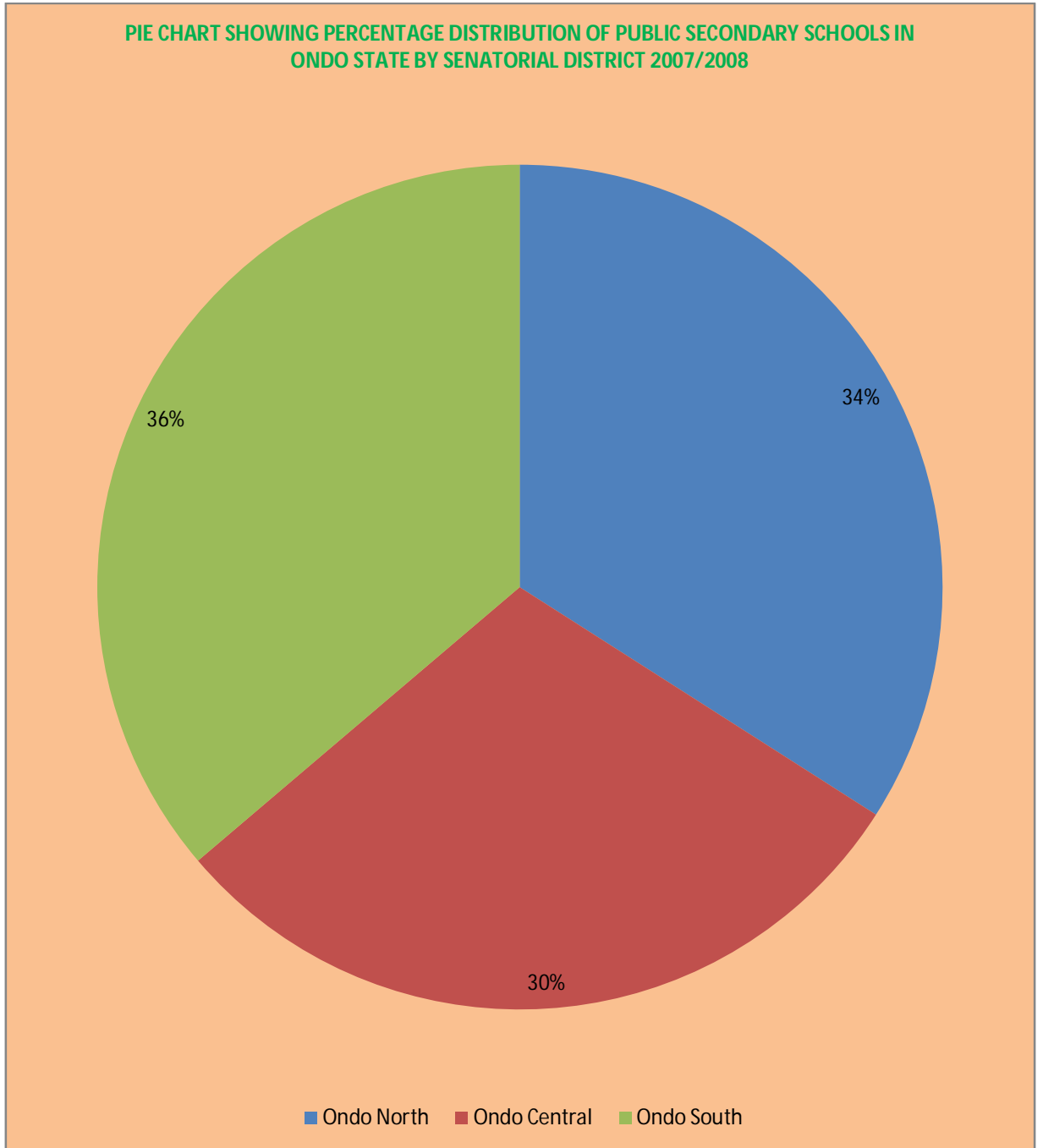

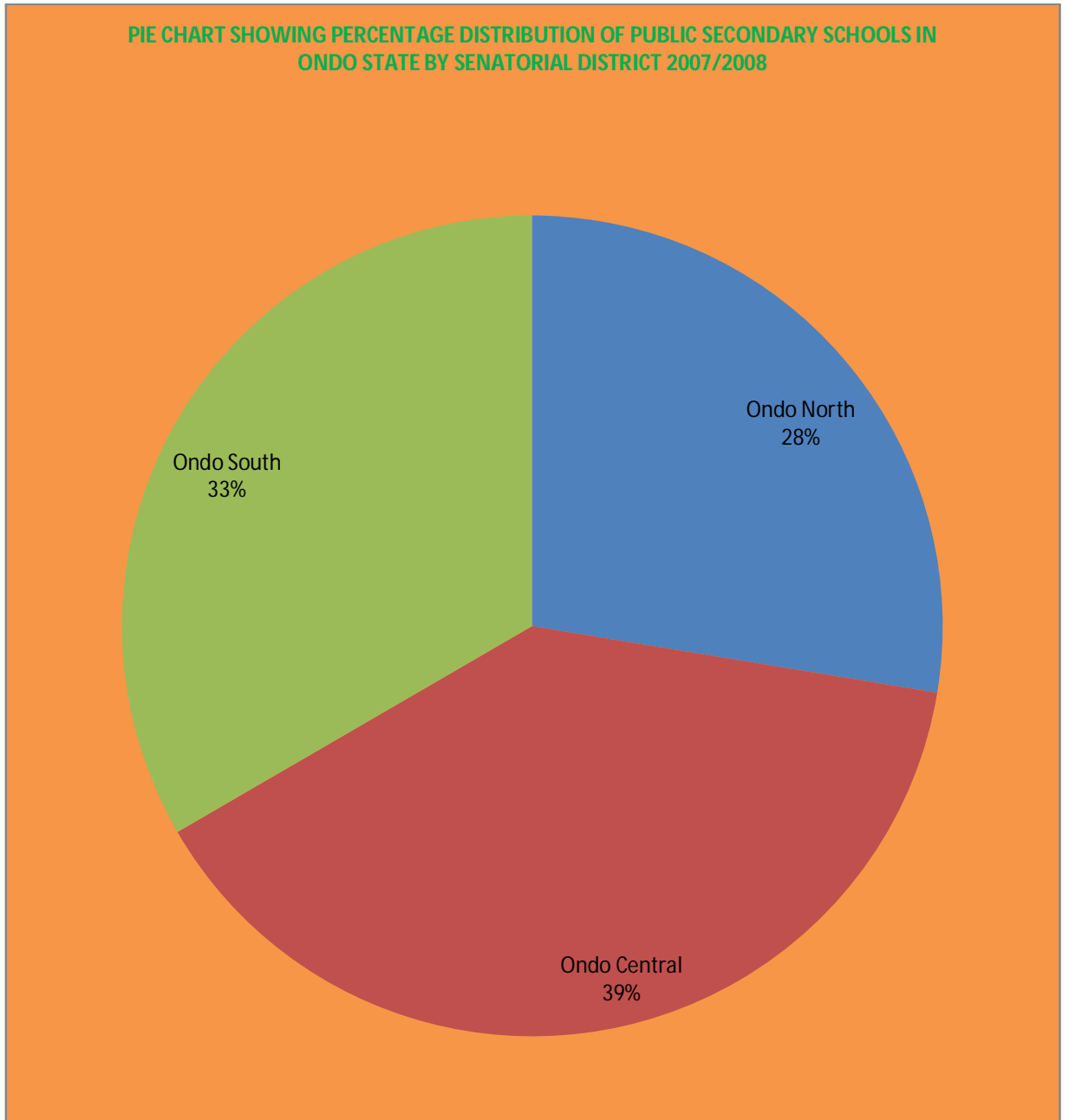

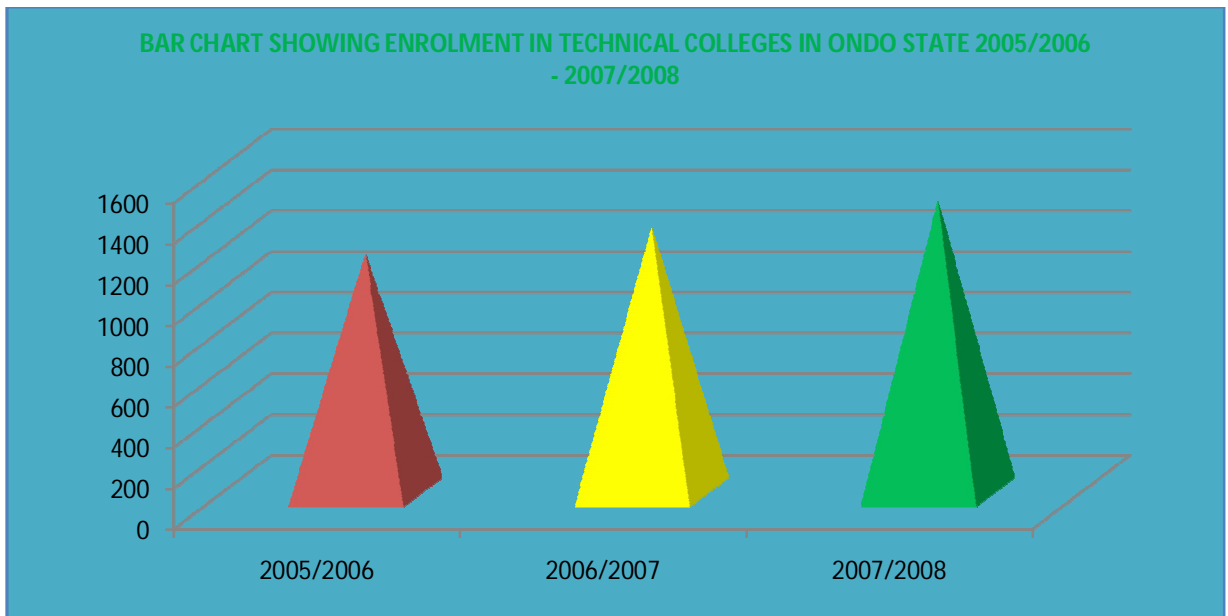

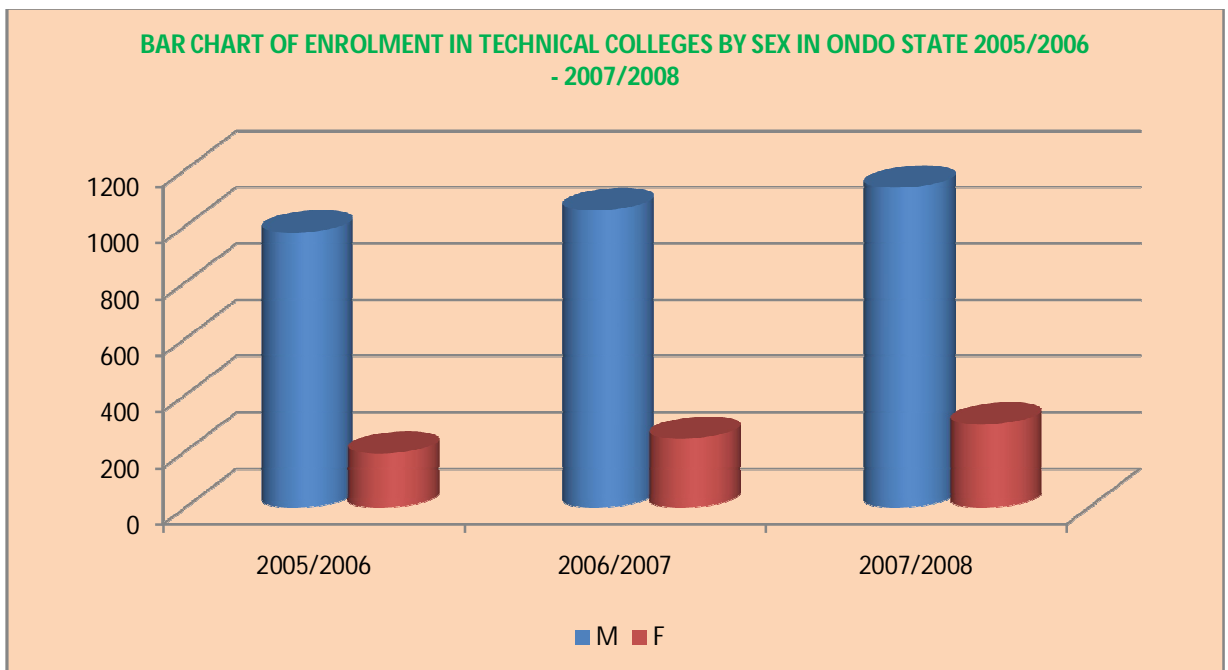

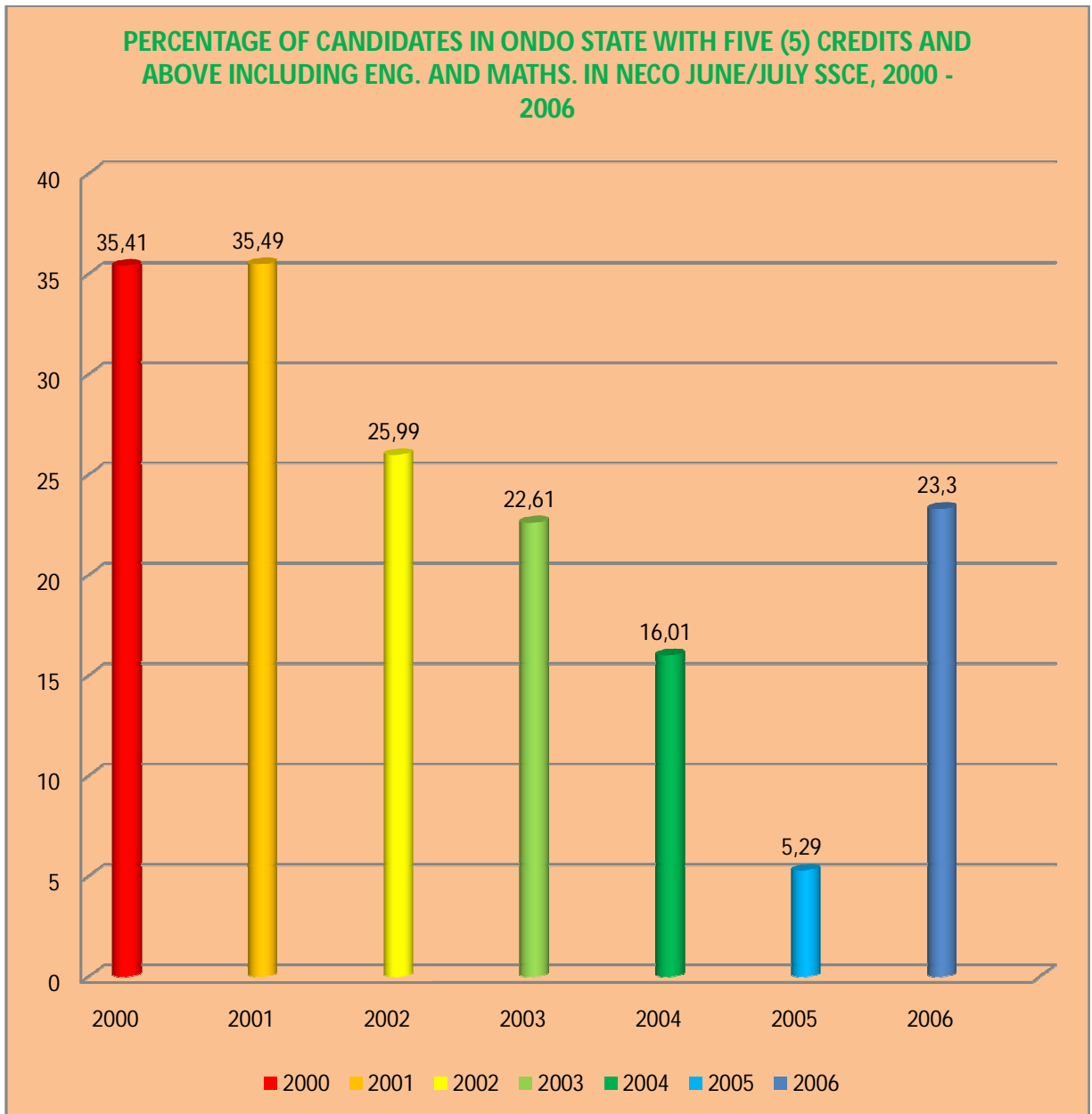
